



COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

LEVEL 1 CLEAN AND DISINFECT-PRO ACTIVE CLEANING

NO CONFIRMED OR SUSPECTED CASES

For areas where there is NO CONFIRMED Coronavirus (COV-19) exposure

This is a proactive clean and wipe only. General clean and disinfection absent of any known or potential contamination. Includes the following:

- Use of a registered EPA disinfectant for application to exposed surfaces.
 - SDS Sheets for disinfectants available upon request.
- Proper worker PPE for level of clean: Coveralls, safety glasses, nitrile gloves and masks.
- Wipe down of high touchpoint areas such as desktops, doors, horizontal surfaces, computers, keyboards, door handles, phones, exterior surfaces in bathrooms, localized high touchpoints on walls, includes non-porous-exterior surfaces only.
- Light fog of registered EPA disinfectant, with dwell time per manufacturer guidelines. Follow up wipe down with disinfectant.

LEVEL 2 / LEVEL 3

SUSPECTED OR CONFIRMED COVID-19 CONTACT

For areas where there is SUSPECTED or CONFIRMED COVID-19 EXPOSURE. Includes areas where there is contact with a person under investigation (PUI) or actual confirmed COVID-19 case. Includes Level 1 cleaning with the addition of the following:

- Specific clean of affected areas that require deep cleaning and disinfection
- Additional PPE for all personnel and service levels
- Containment of affected areas
- Air controls for affected areas
- Third party IHQ to perform ATP testing of affected areas to determine biological load
 - Note: As of this writing, there is no known "clearance test" for the COVID-19 virus.
- Use of a registered EPA disinfectant for application to exterior surfaces.
 - SDS Sheets for disinfectants available upon request.
