












Price Range of Comps Sold




Price per Square Foot of Comps Sold


This chart shows the distribution of homes reported sold in the past three months at different prices per square foot.




Age Range of Comps Sold






Population of Adults by Age Group




Household Income Brackets








How People Get to Work


Average Monthly Temperature
