




### Median Listing Price vs. Listing Volume



Sales Count By Price Range




### Price per Square Foot of Comps Sold

Sales Count By Price Per Sq Ft






#### Size of Homes Sold




#### Age Range of Comps Sold






#### Median Sales Price vs. Unemployment






