








#### **Price per Square Foot of Comps Sold**




#### Age Range of Comps Sold





This chart shows the percentage of people in an area who have less than a ninth grade education, compared with other geographies.










## Population of Children by Age Group in New River






#### **Households With Children in New River**






## **Occupational Categories in New River**






### **Presidential Voting Pattern in New River**










## **How People Get to Work**








## **Average Monthly Temperature**
