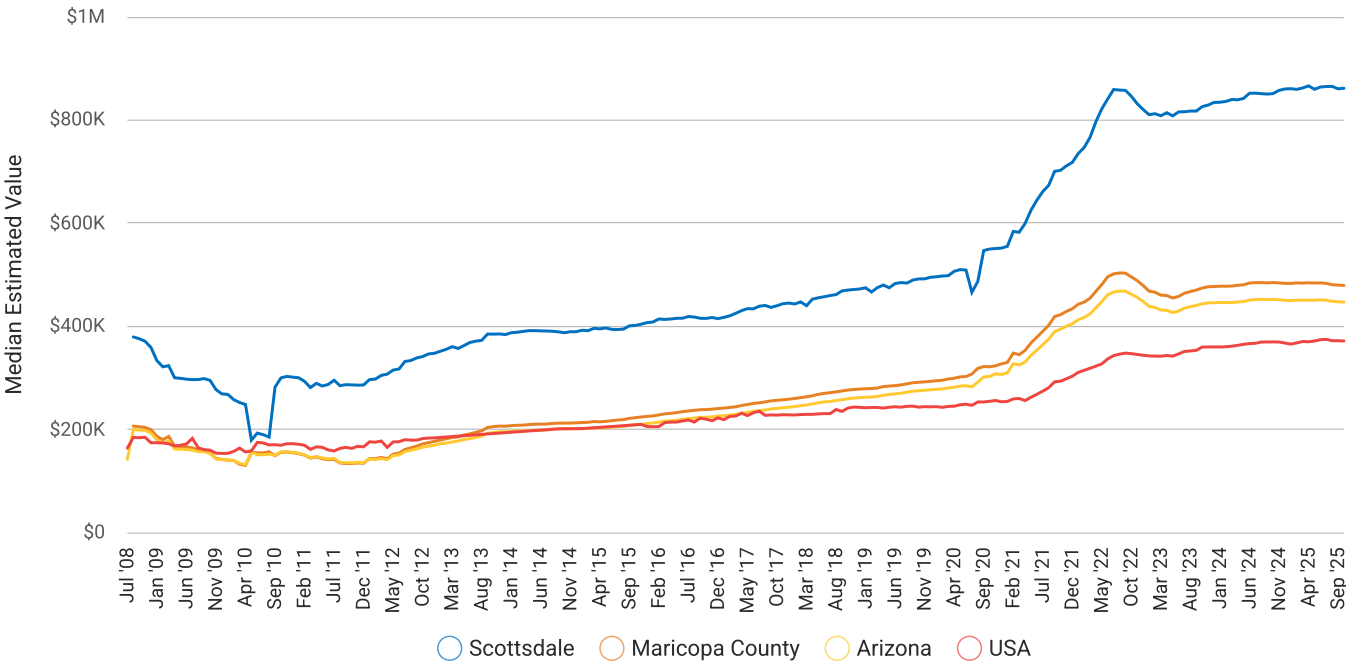

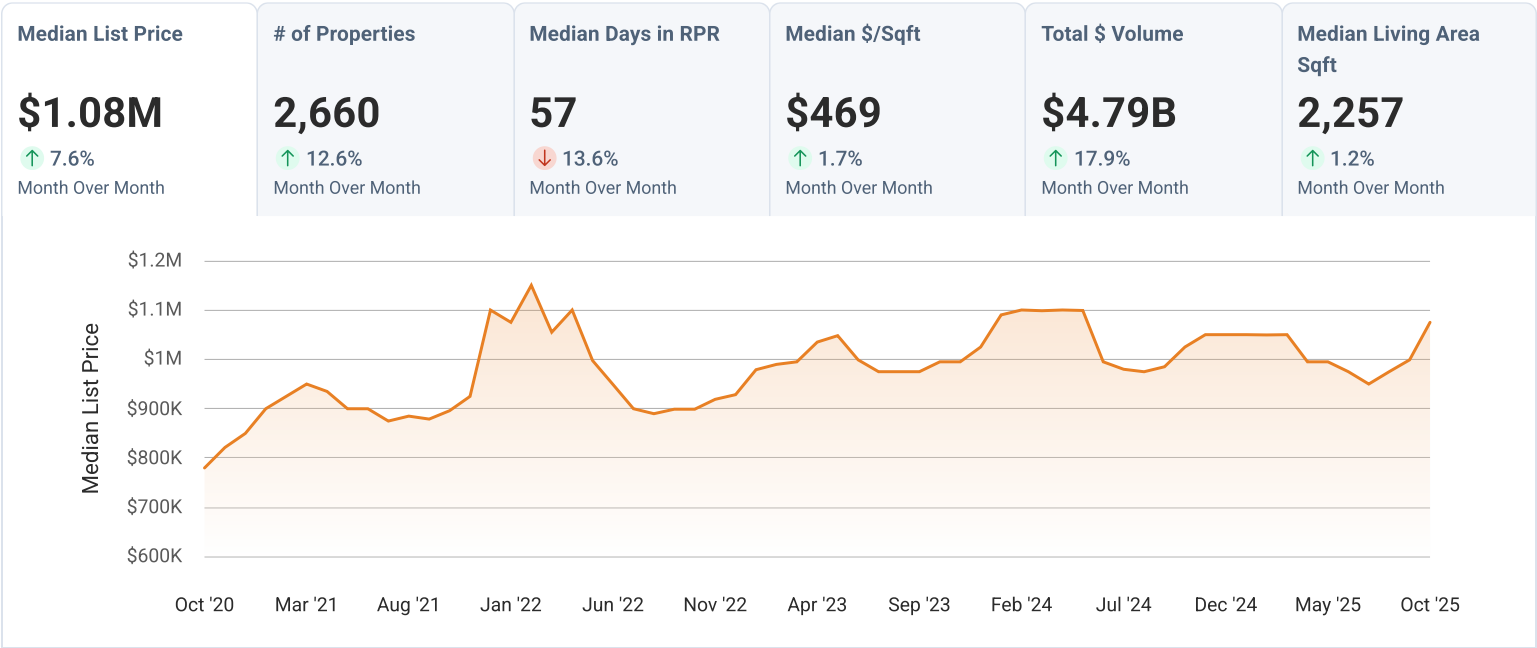

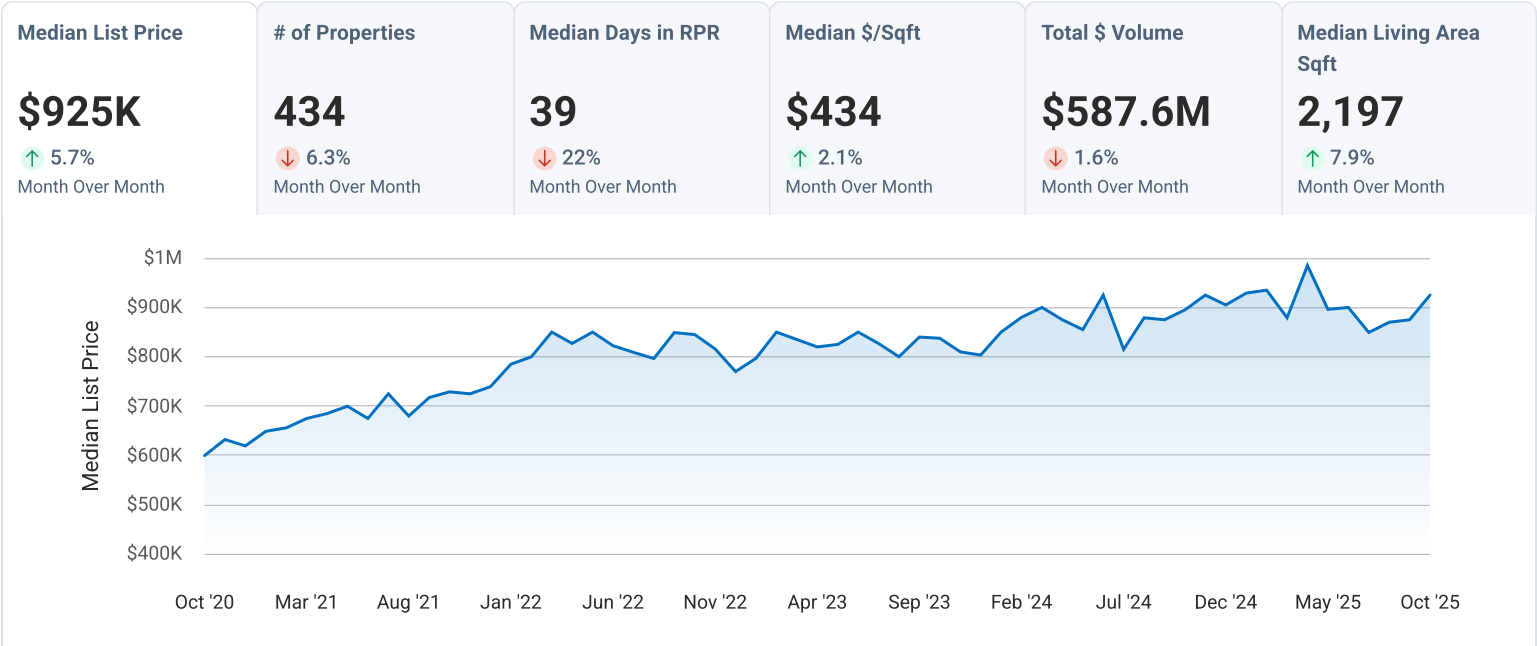

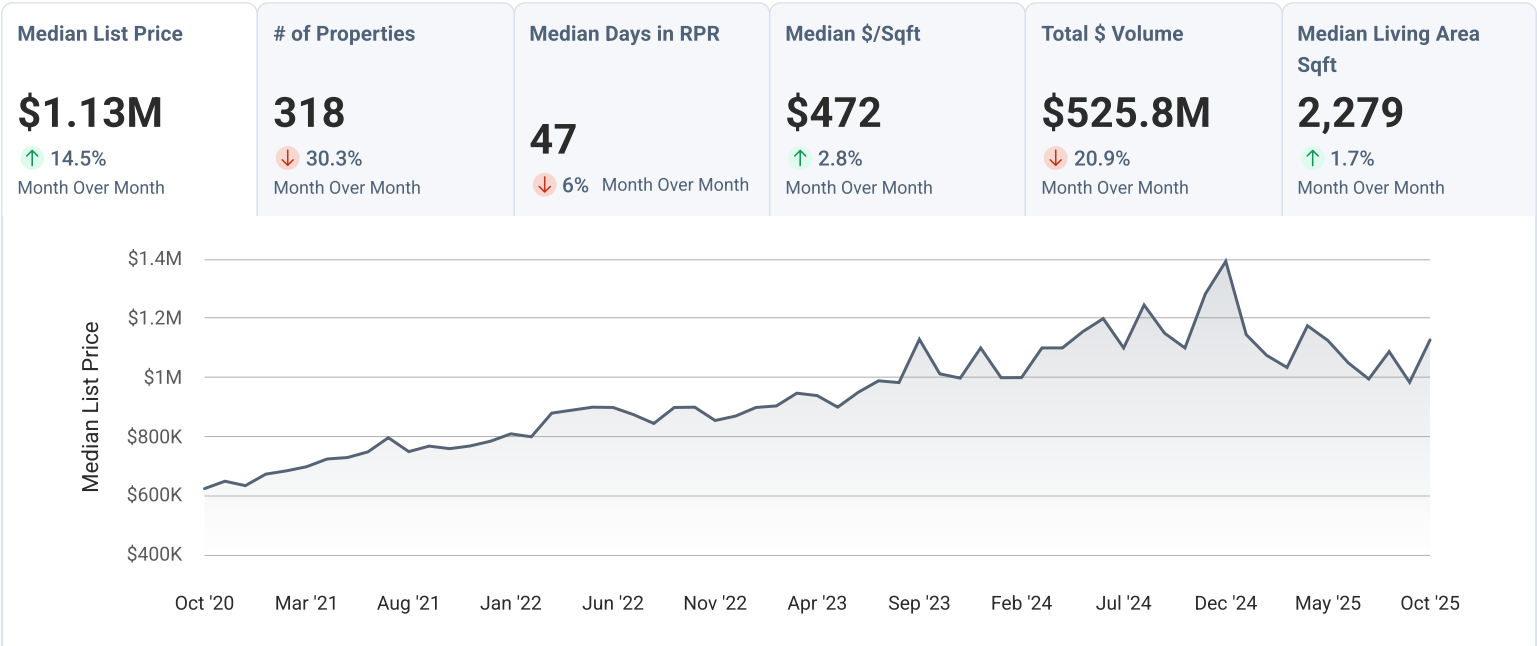

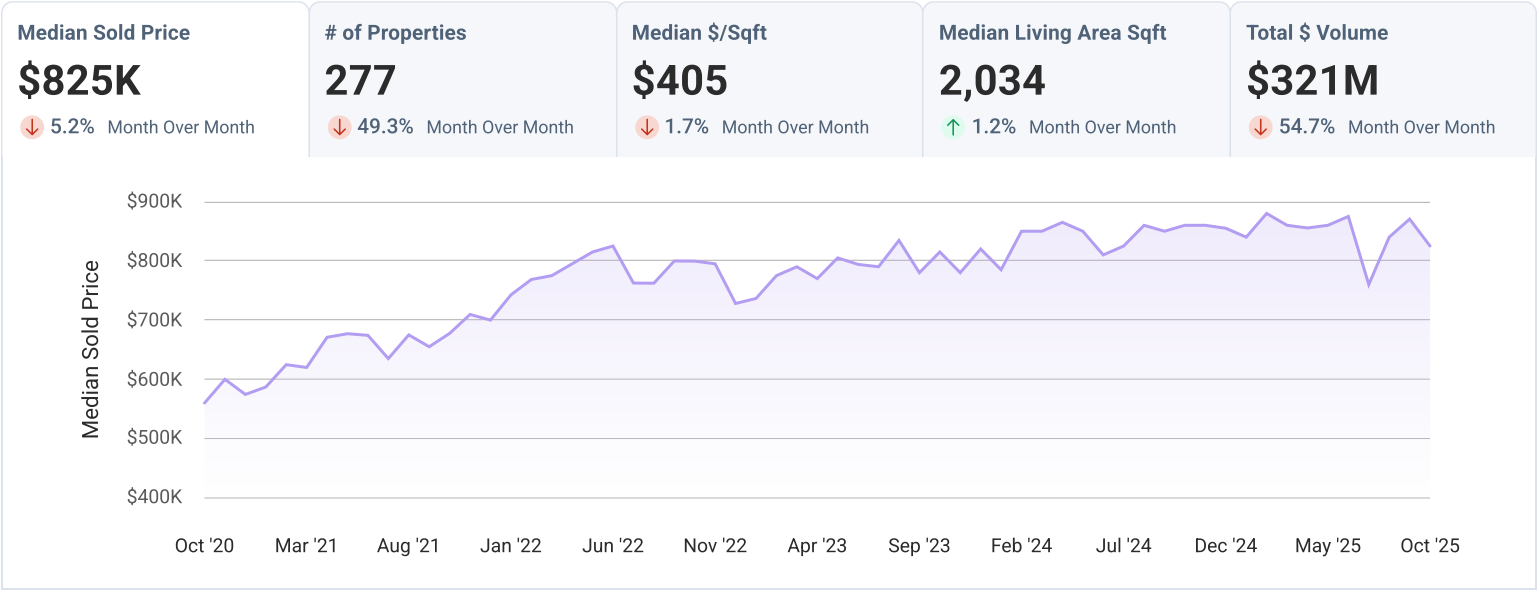

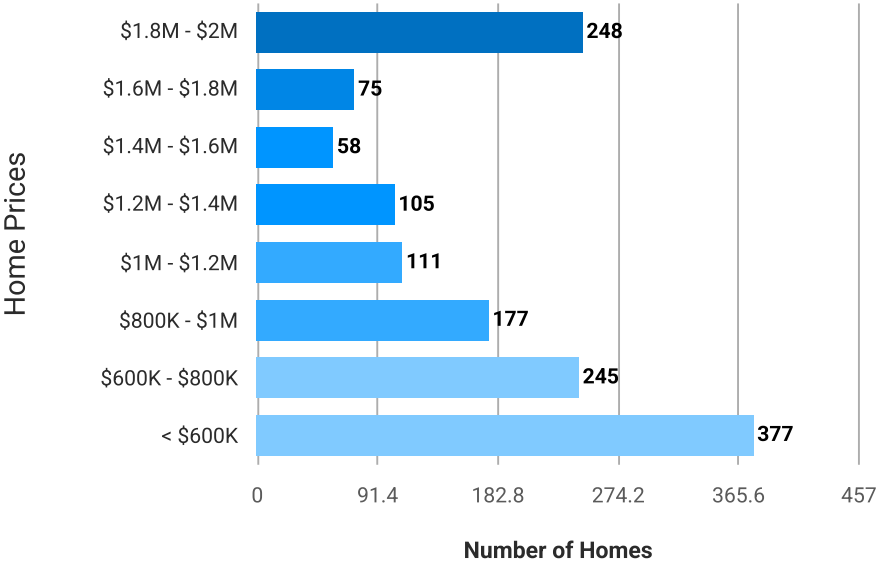

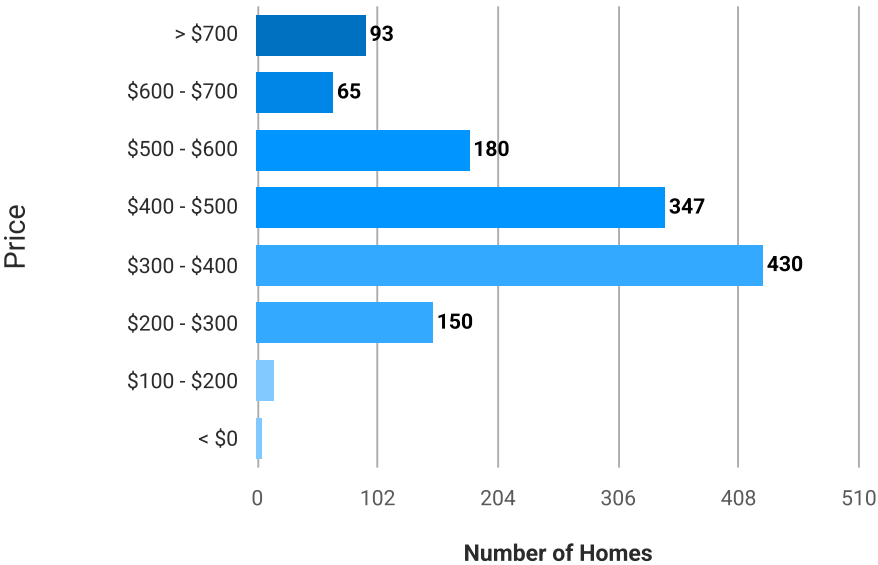


Price per Square Foot of Comps Sold

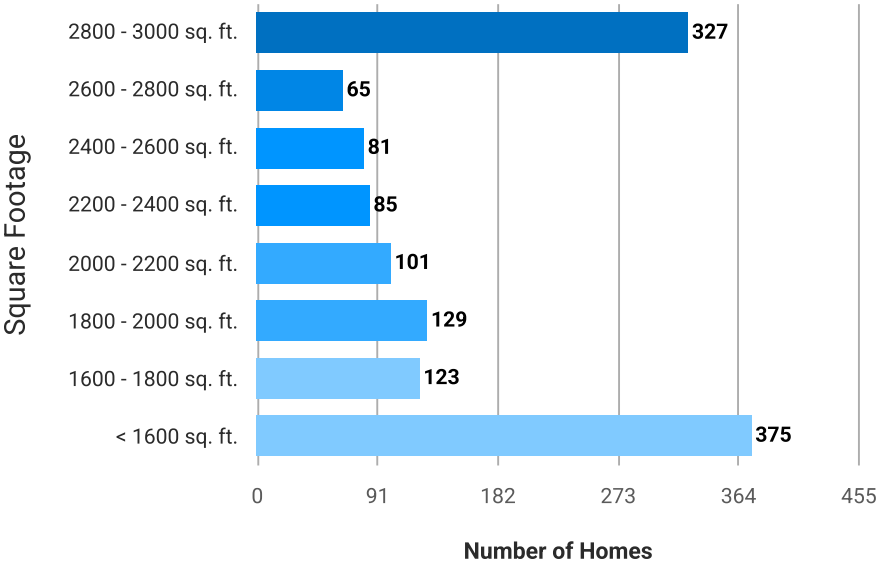


Size of Homes Sold

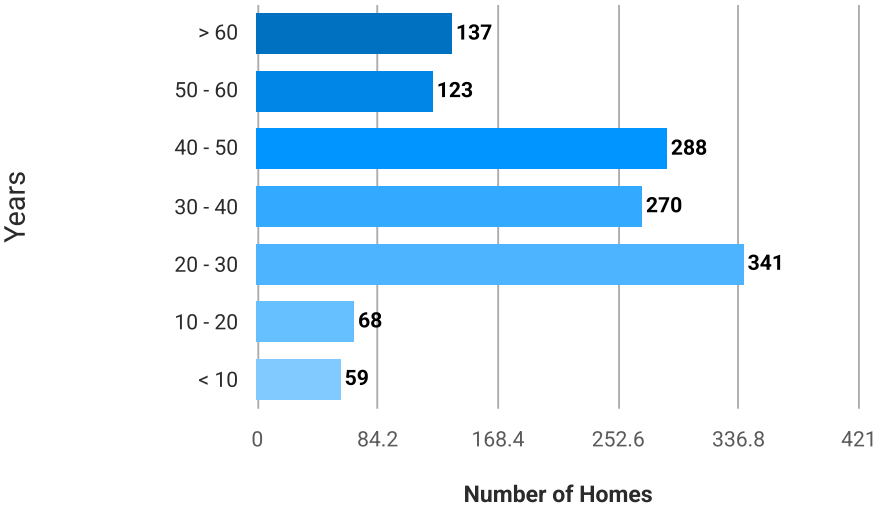


Age Range of Comps Sold

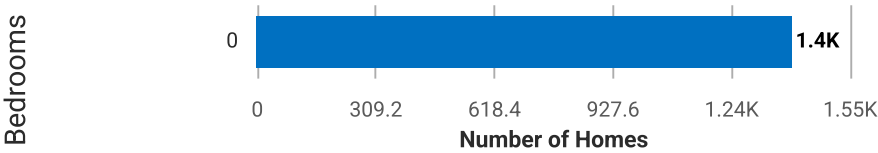


Number of Bedrooms in Homes Sold

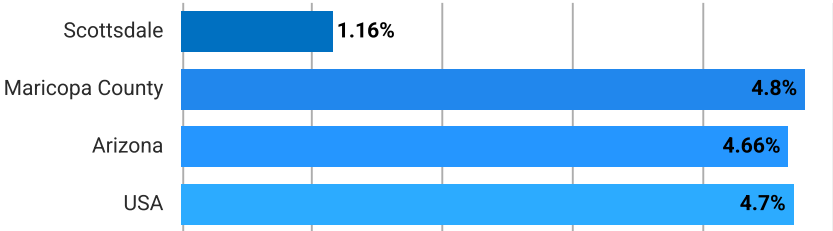

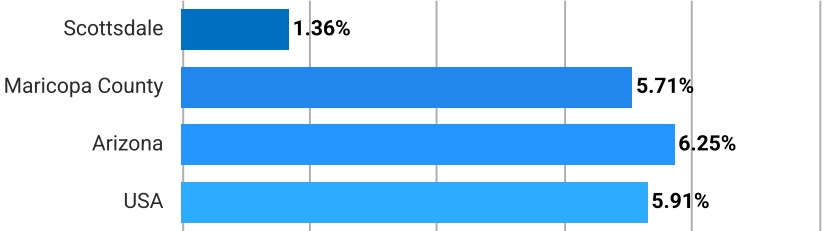

This chart shows the percentage of people in an area who have less than a ninth grade education, compared with other geographies.



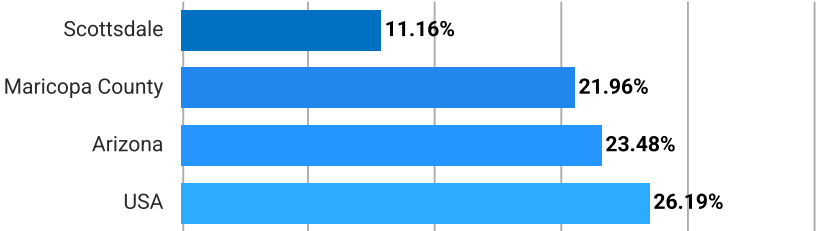
Some High School

This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is high school, compared with other geographies.

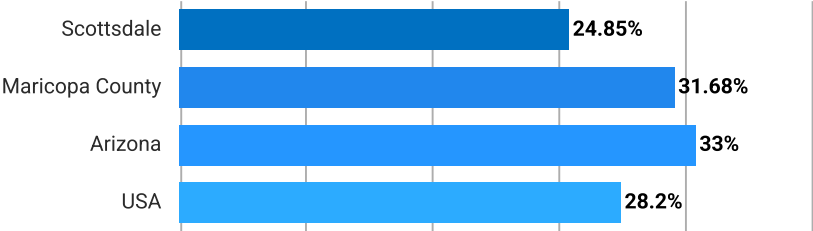

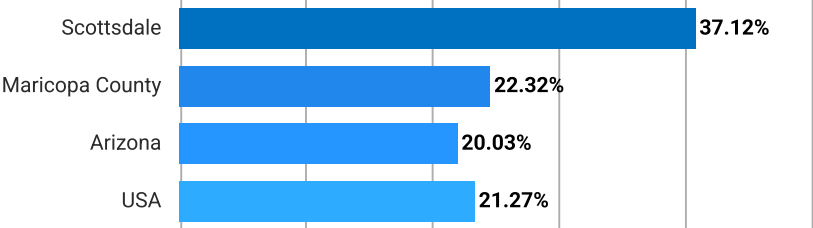
Associate Degree

This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is an associate degree, compared with other geographies.



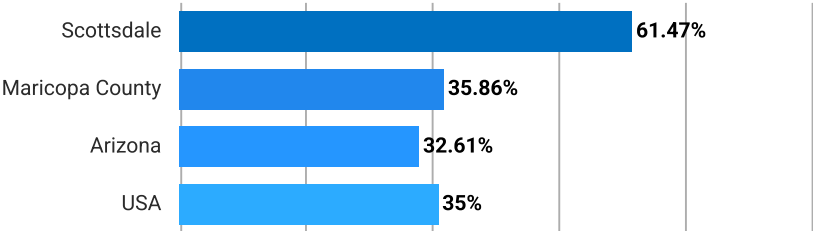
Bachelor's Degree

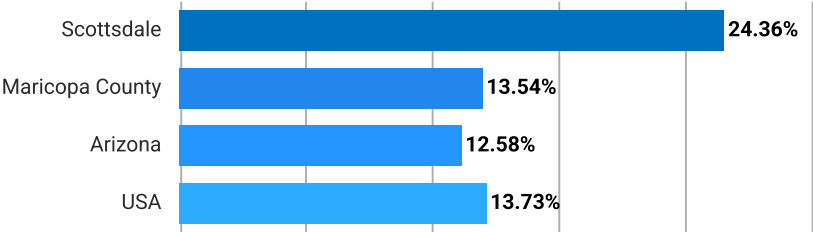
Some College

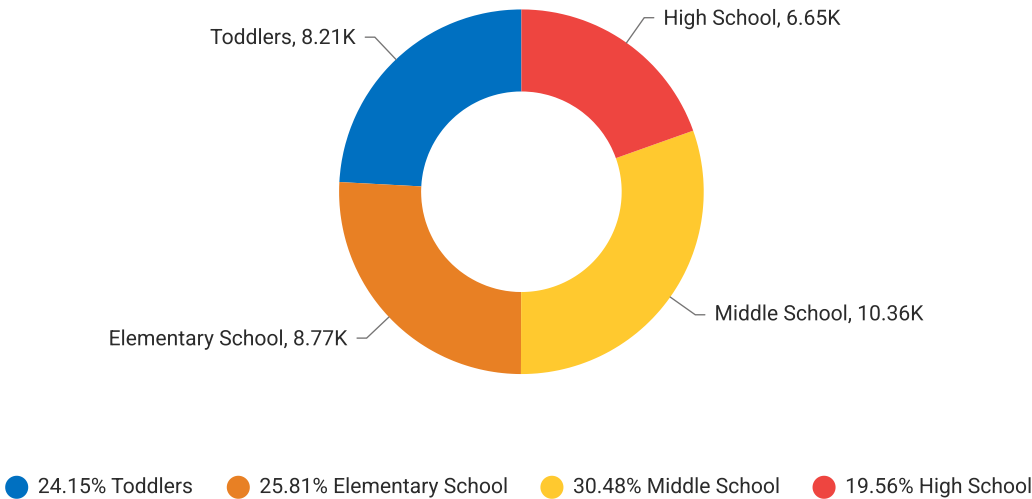


Population of Children by Age Group in Scottsdale

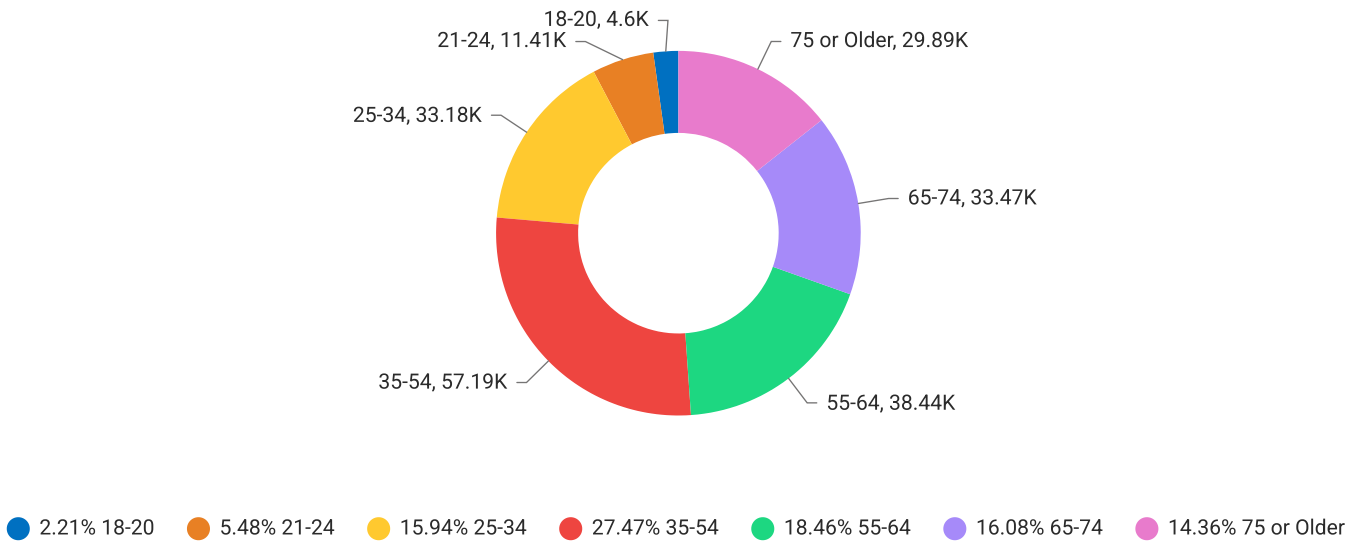


Population of Adults by Age Group in Scottsdale

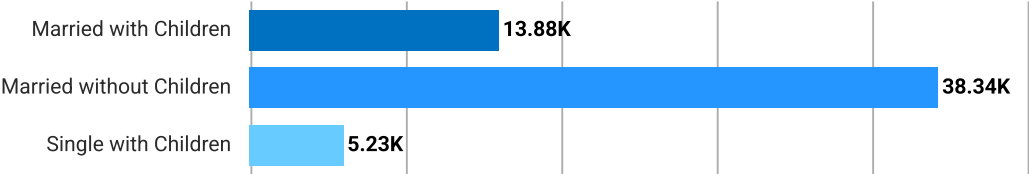


Households With Children in Scottsdale

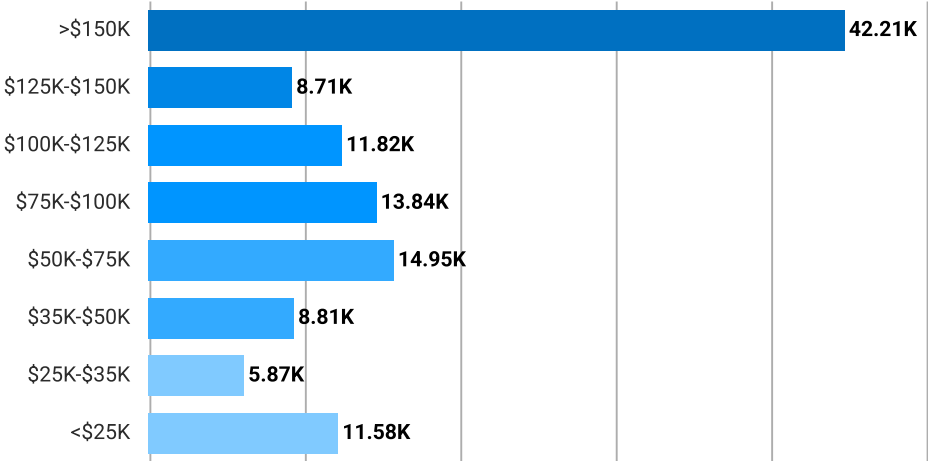


Household Income Brackets in Scottsdale

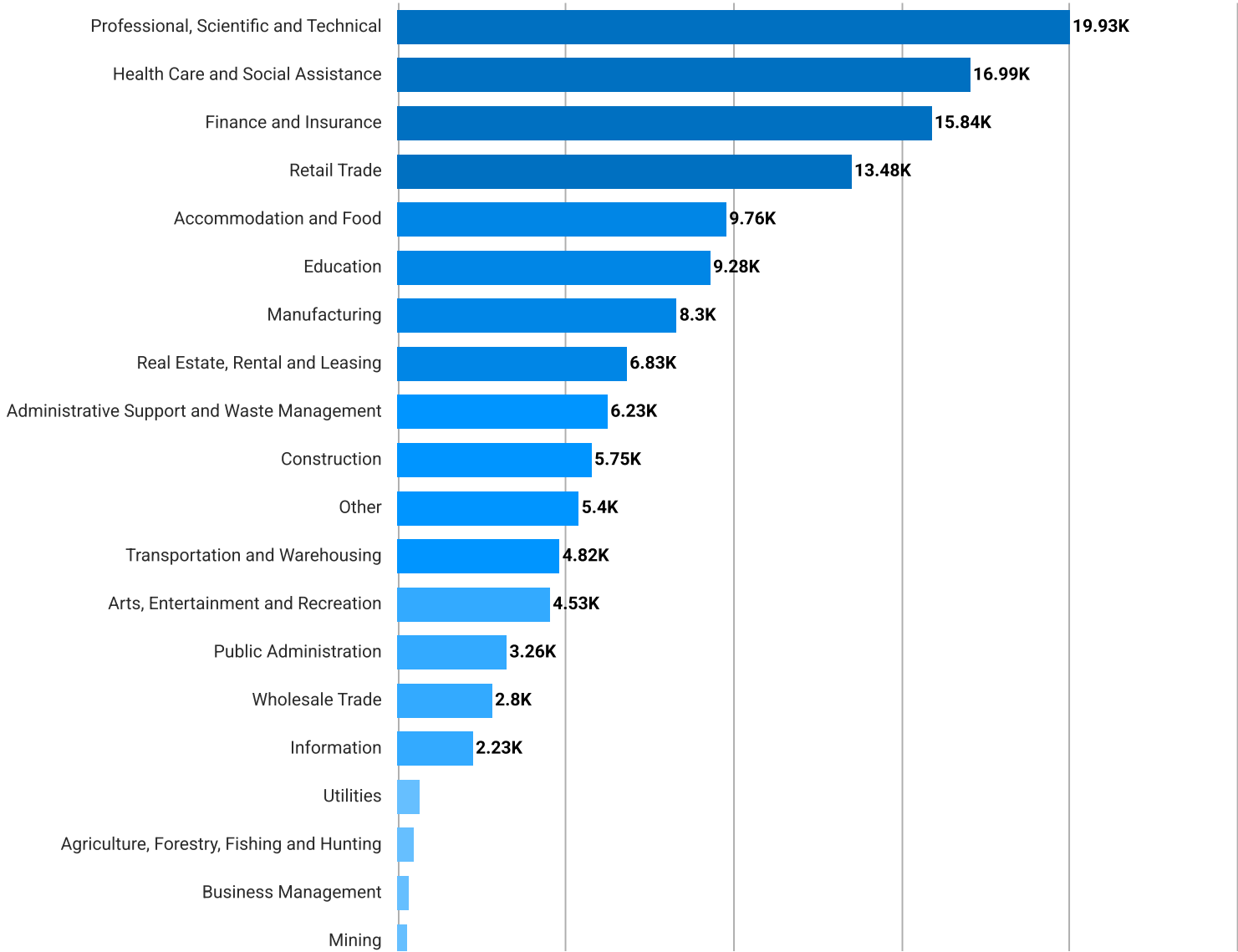


Occupational Categories in Scottsdale

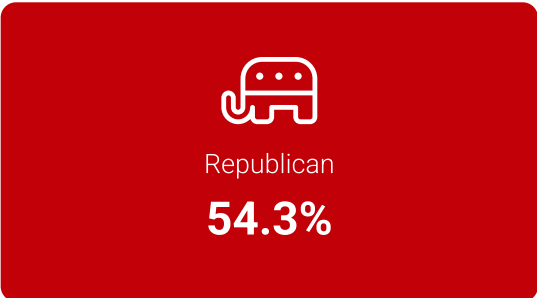
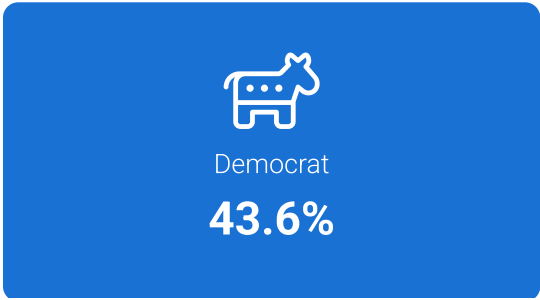


Presidential Voting Pattern in Scottsdale

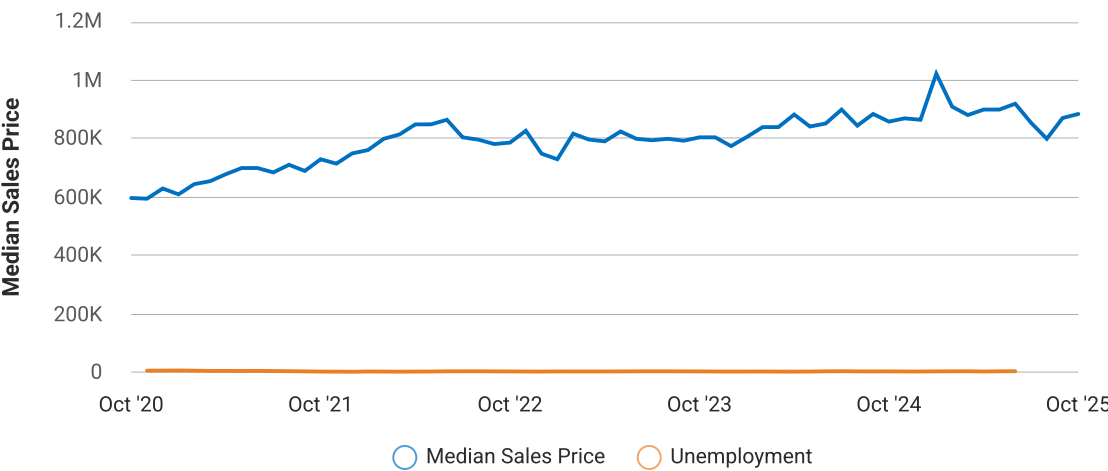

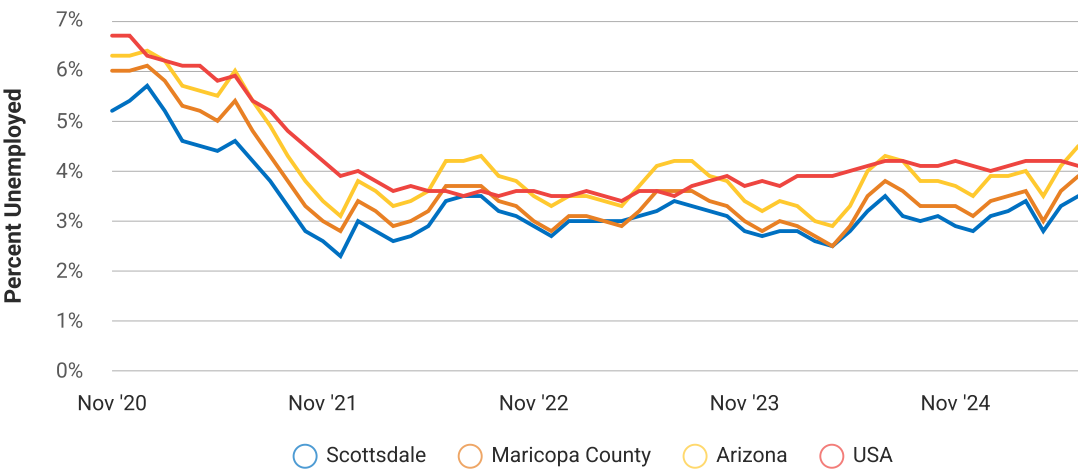


Unemployment Rate

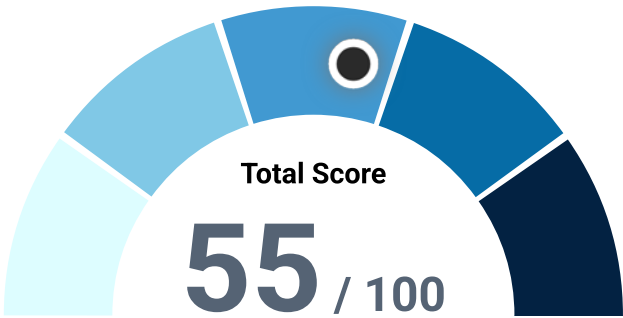

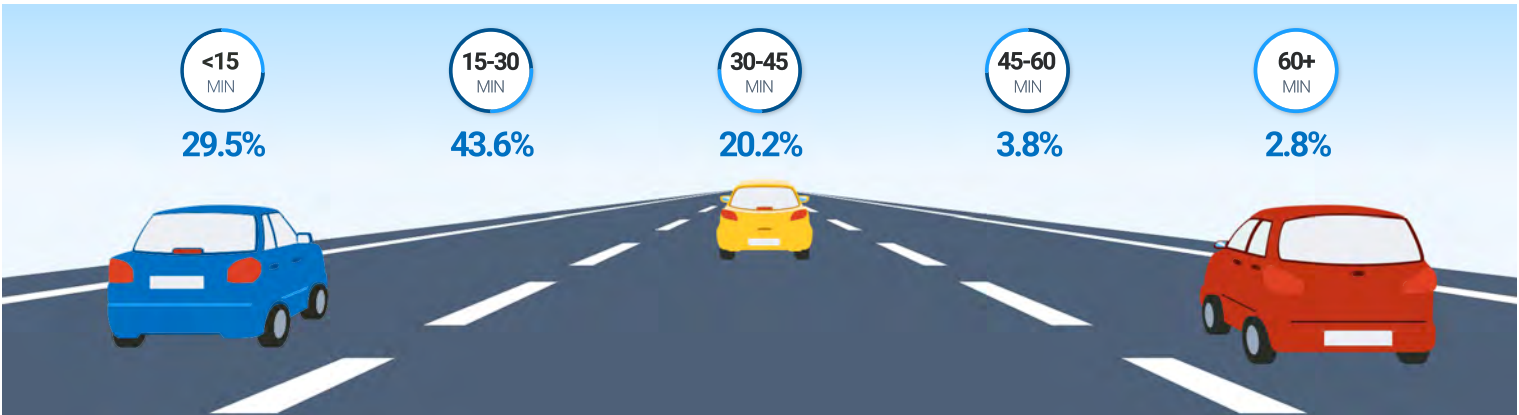

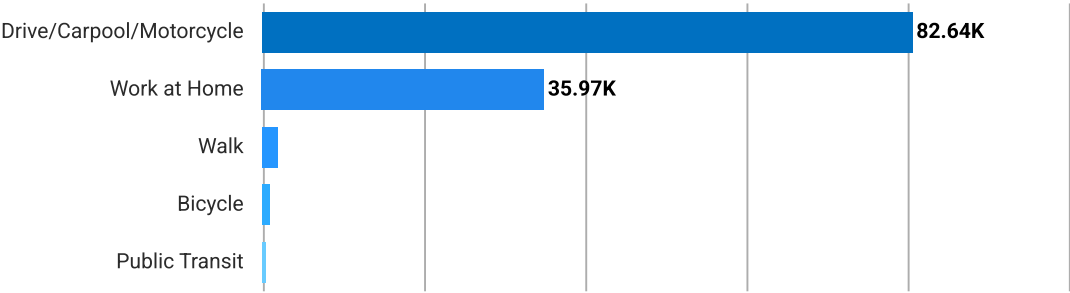


How People Get to Work

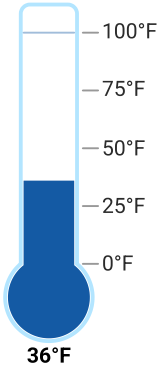
Average Monthly Temperature

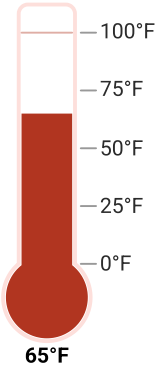

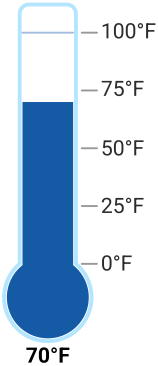

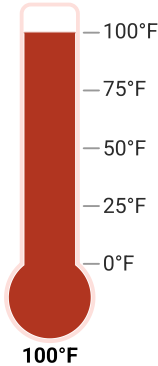
