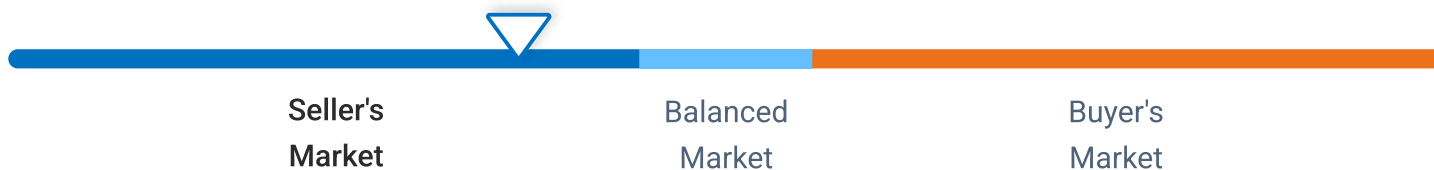

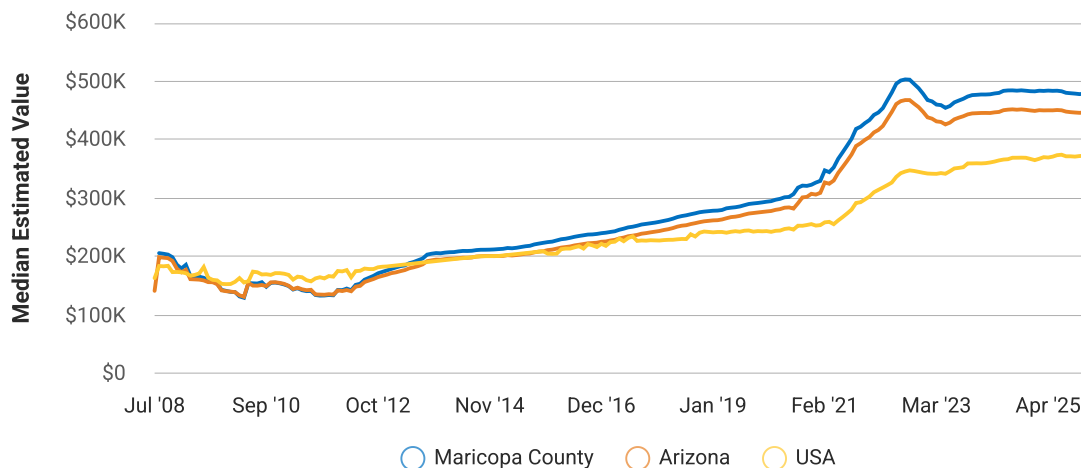

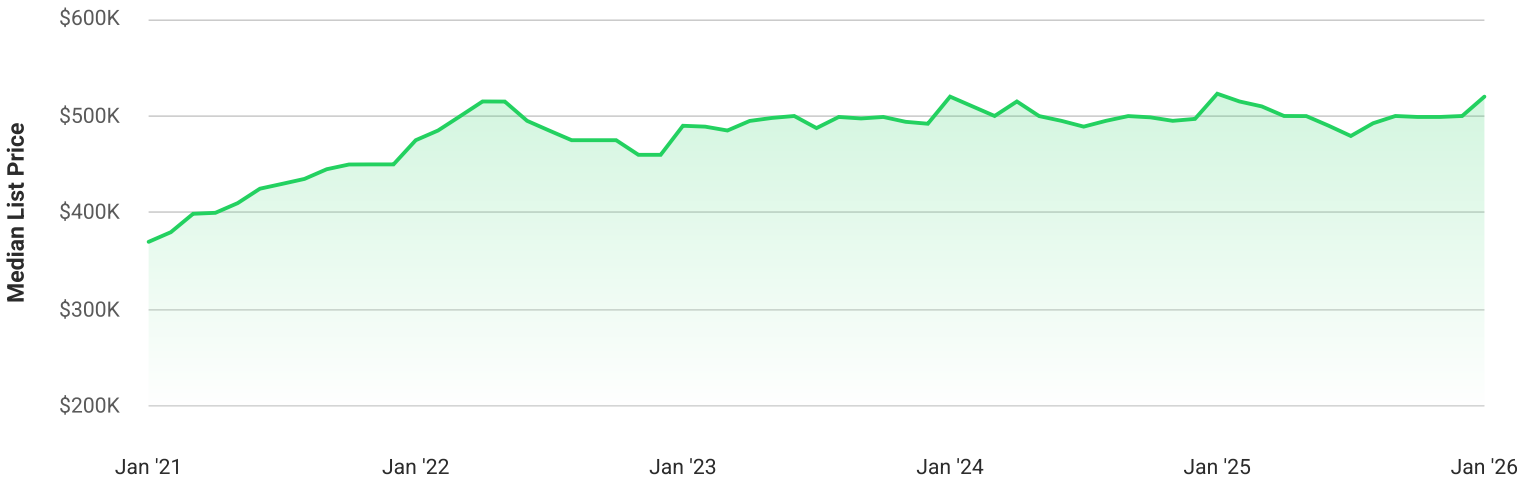

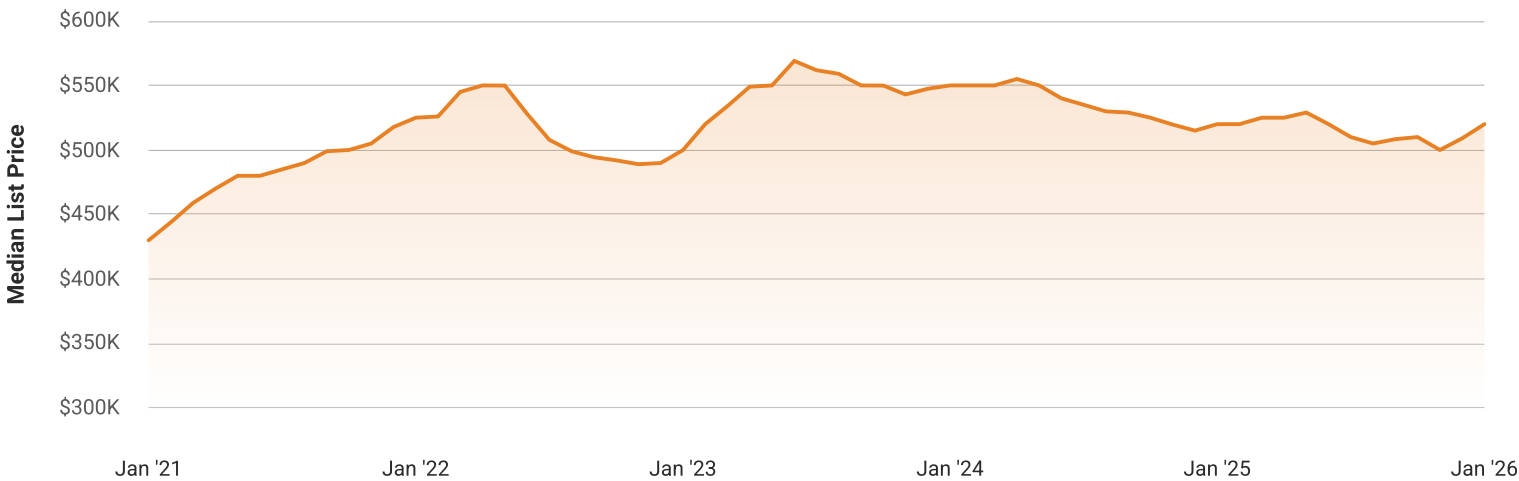

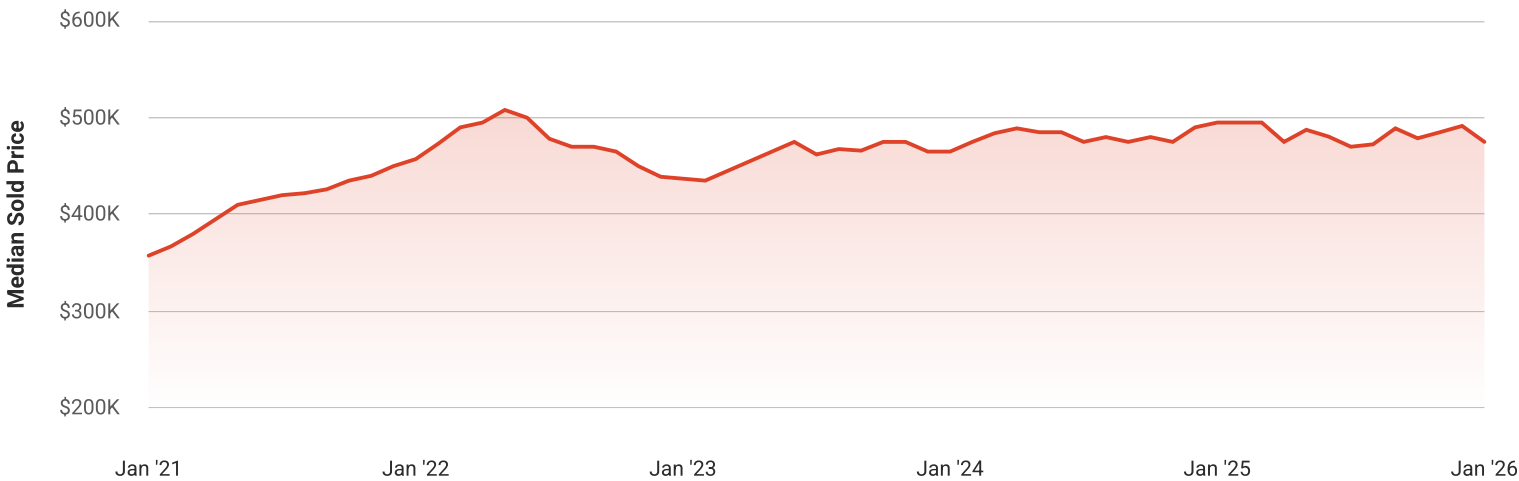

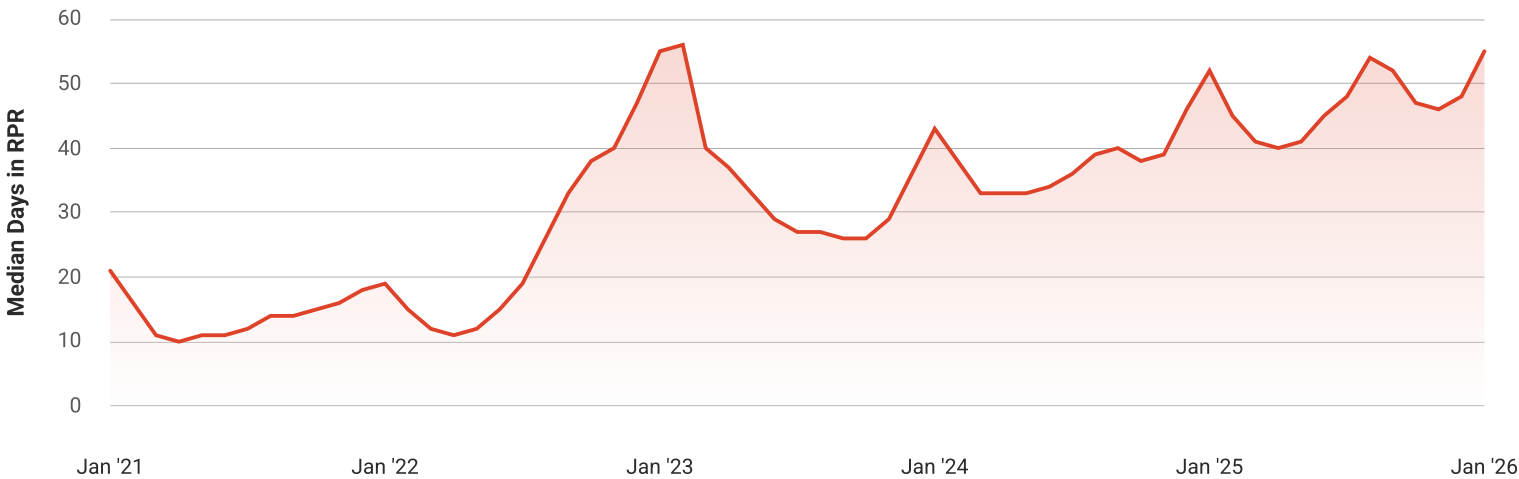

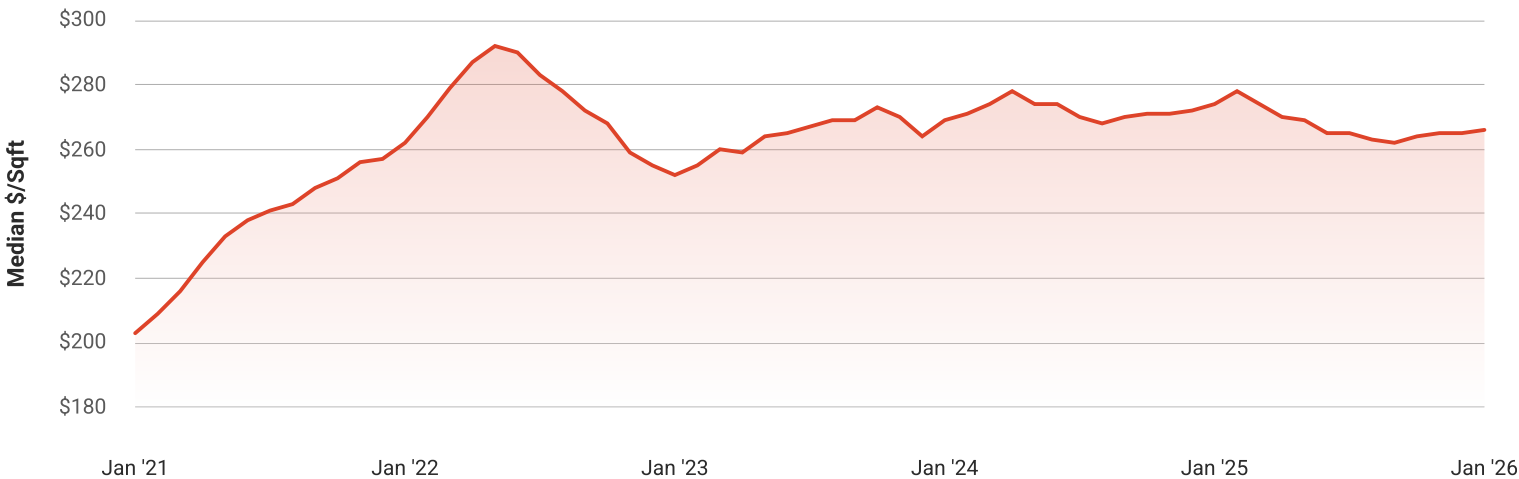

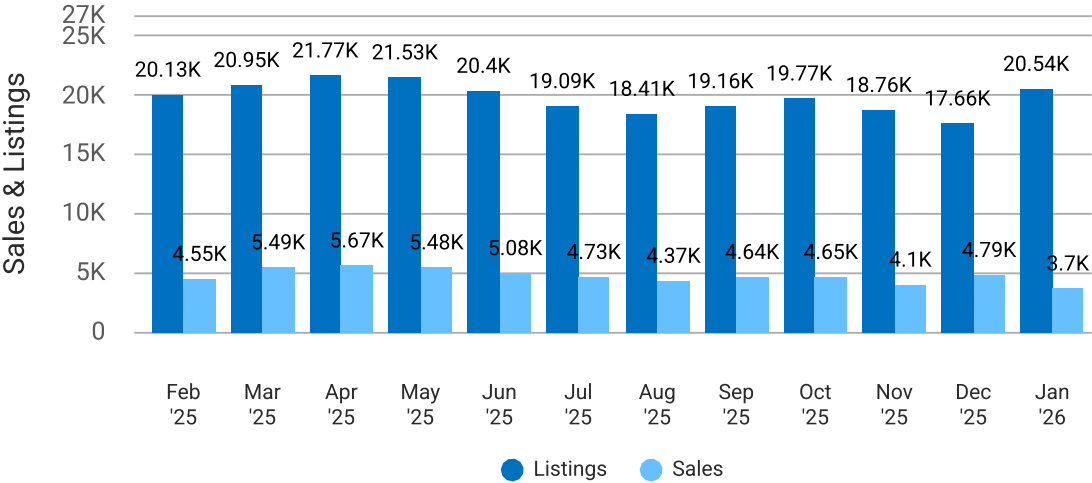
Total Sales and Active Listings in Maricopa County, Arizona

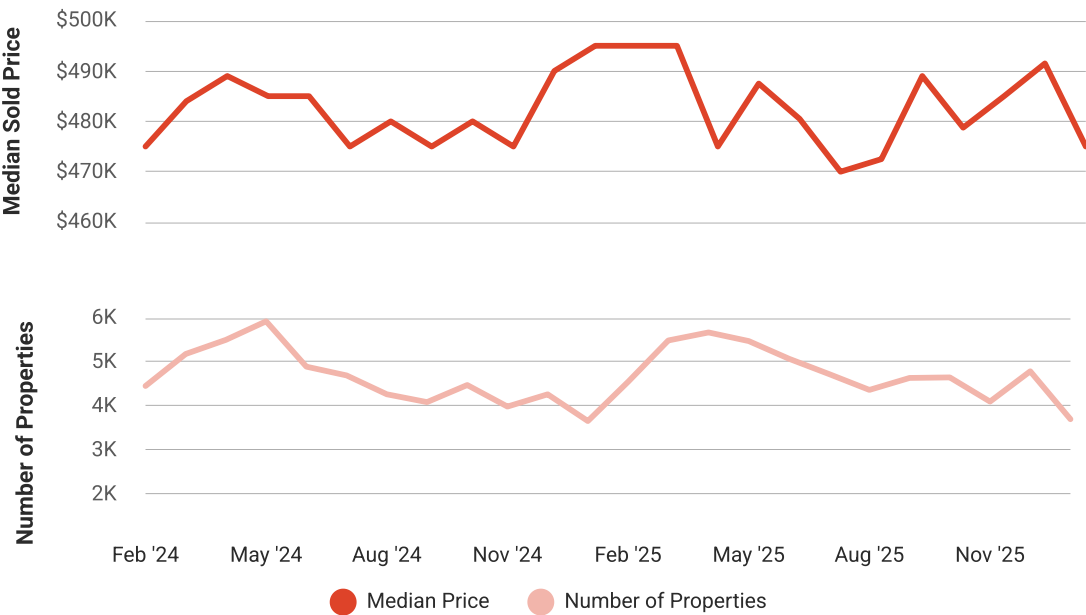
Median Sold Price vs Sold Listings in Maricopa County, Arizona

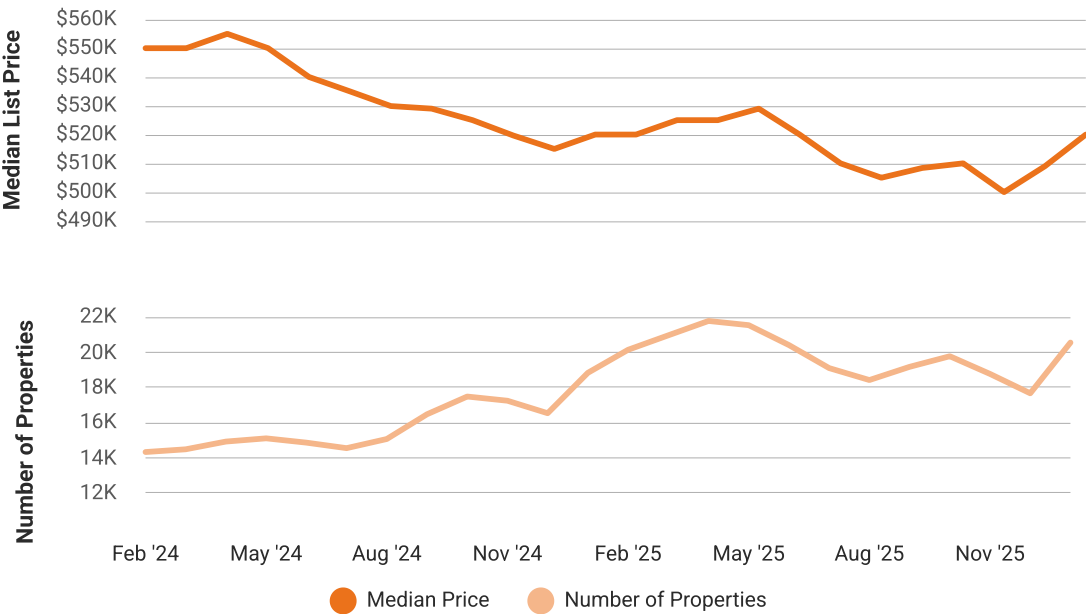
Median List Price vs Active Listings in Maricopa County, Arizona

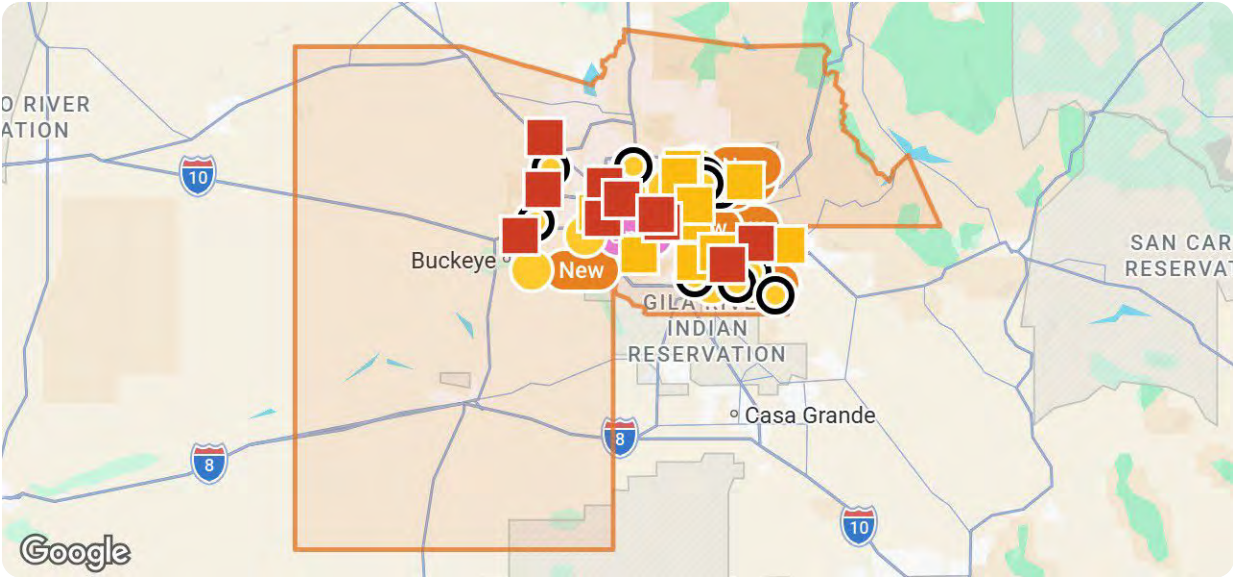

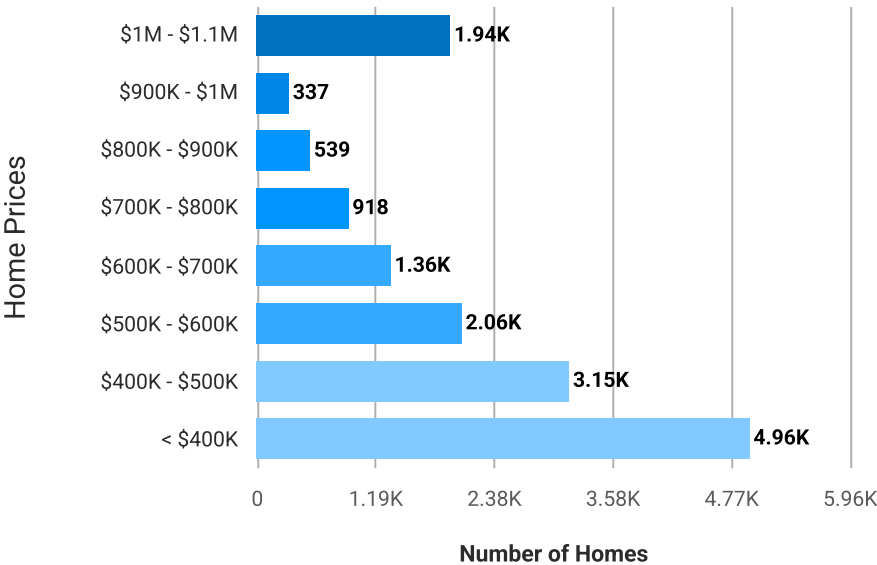

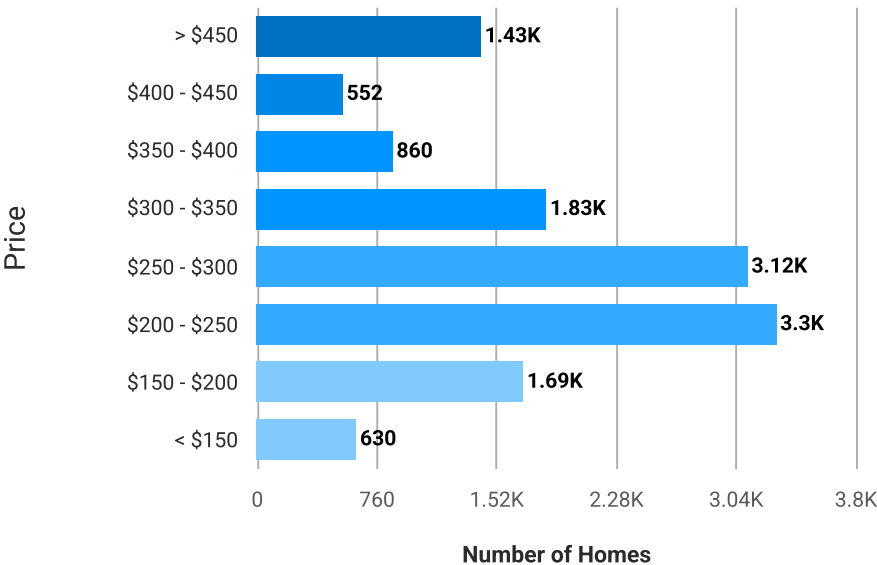


Price per Square Foot of Comps Sold

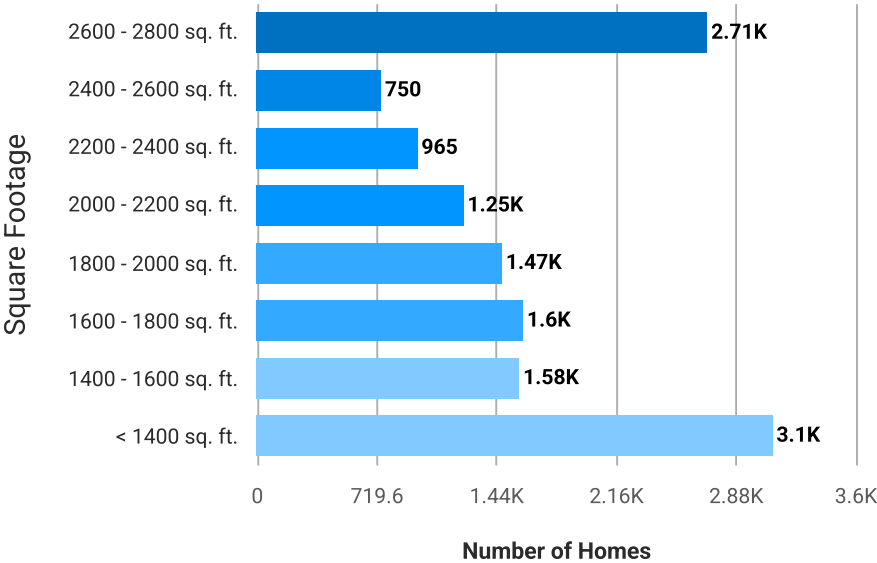


Size of Homes Sold

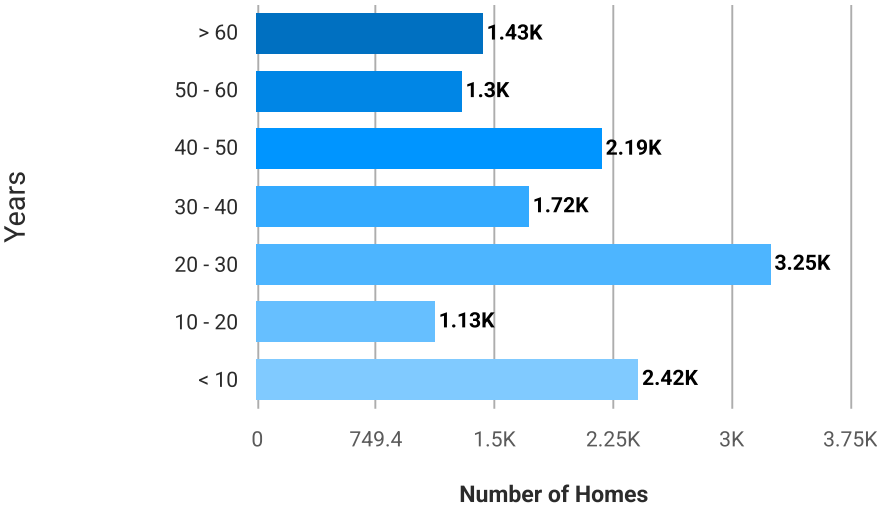


Age Range of Comps Sold

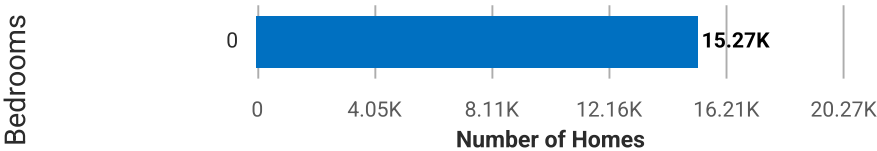


Number of Bedrooms in Homes Sold

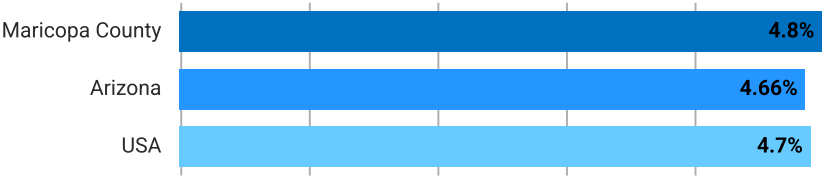

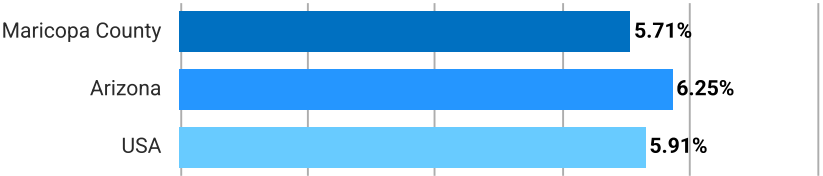

This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is some high school, without graduating or passing a high school GED test, compared with other geographies.



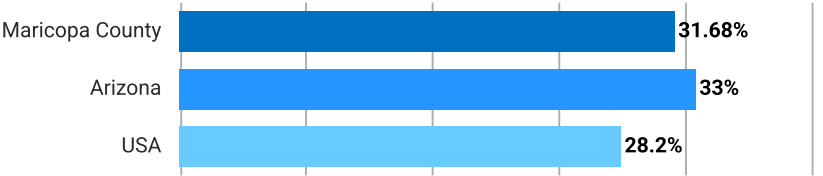
High School Graduate

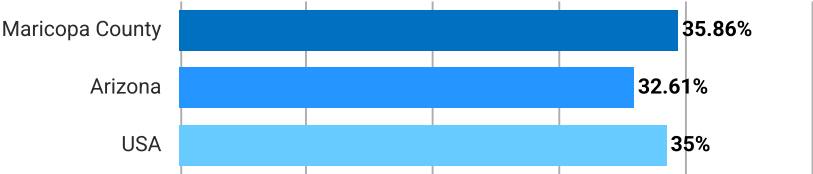
Bachelor's Degree

This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is a graduate or professional degree, compared with other geographies.

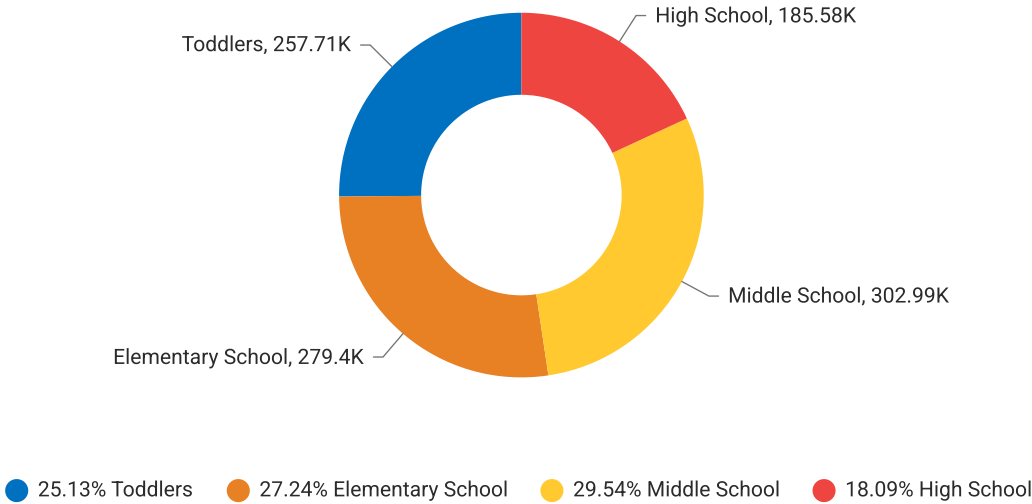


Population of Children by Age Group in Maricopa County

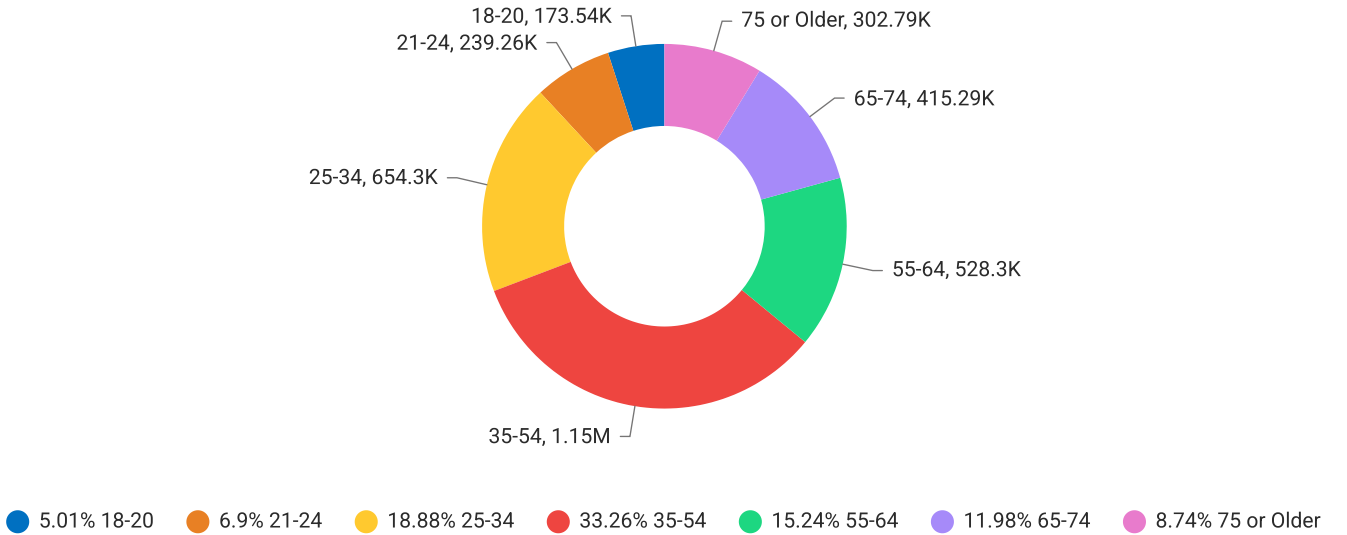

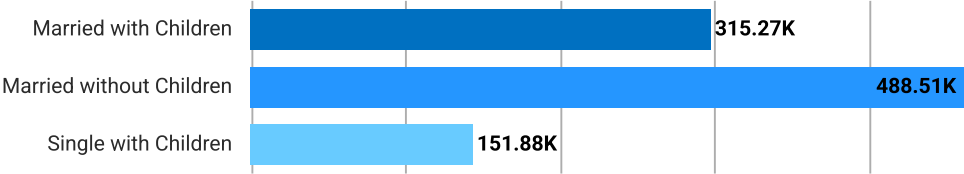


Households With Children in Maricopa County

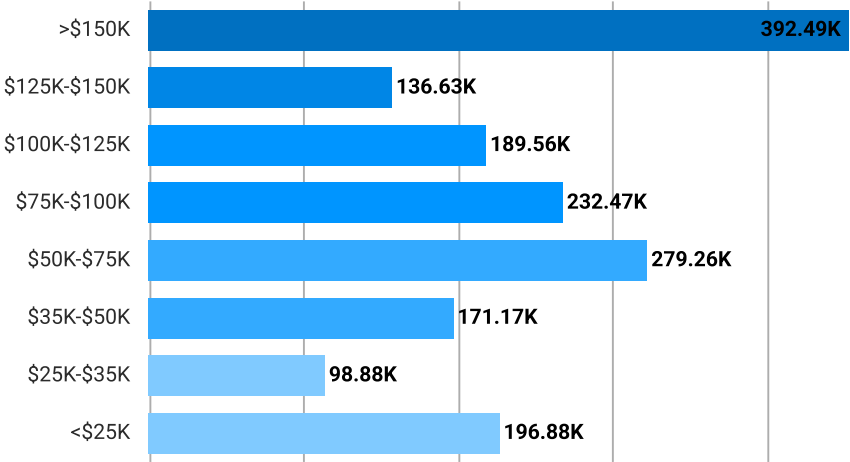


Household Income Brackets in Maricopa County

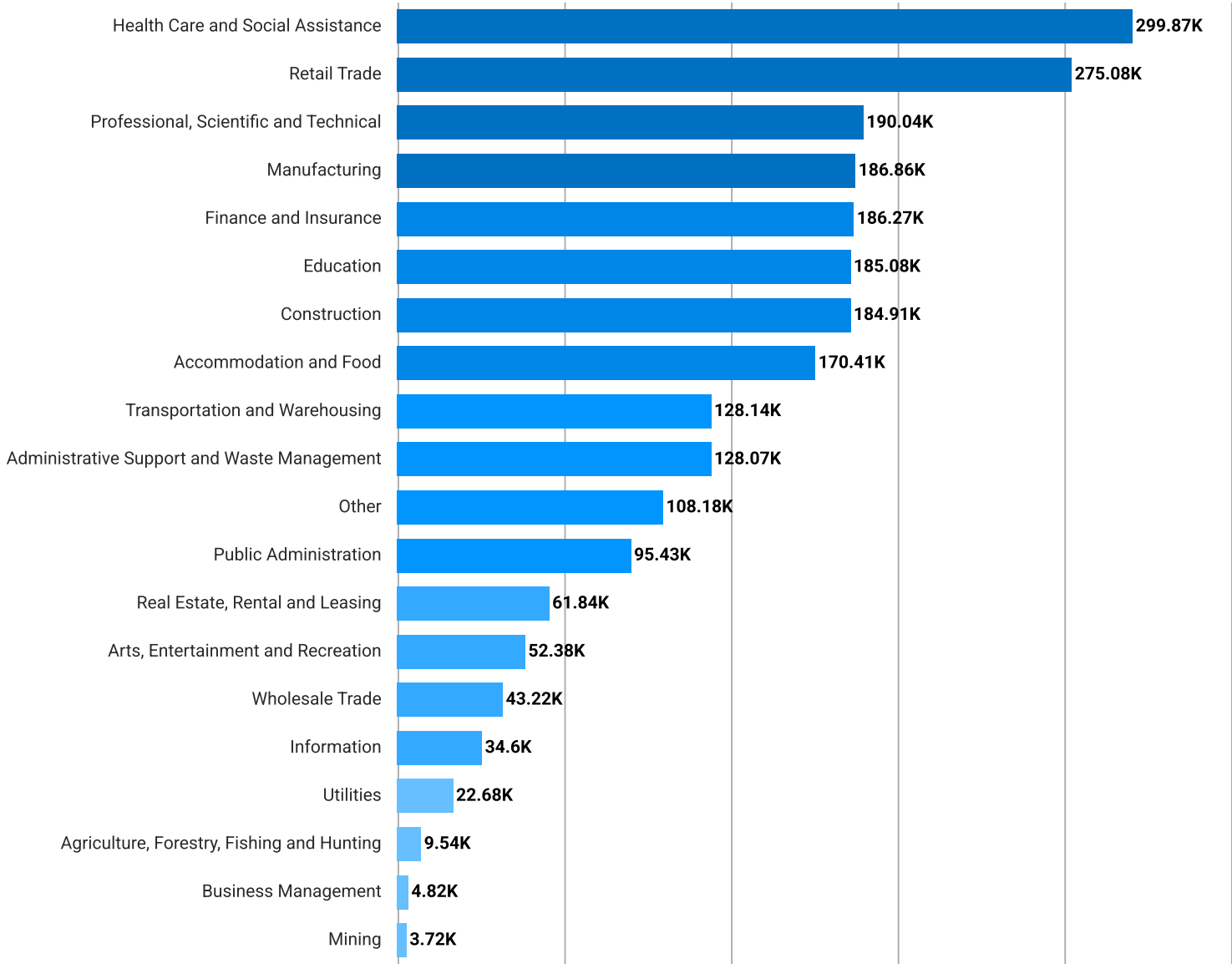


Occupational Categories in Maricopa County

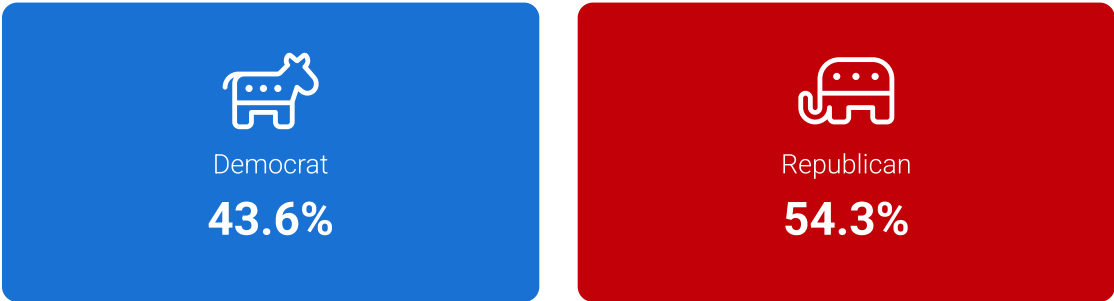


Presidential Voting Pattern in Maricopa County

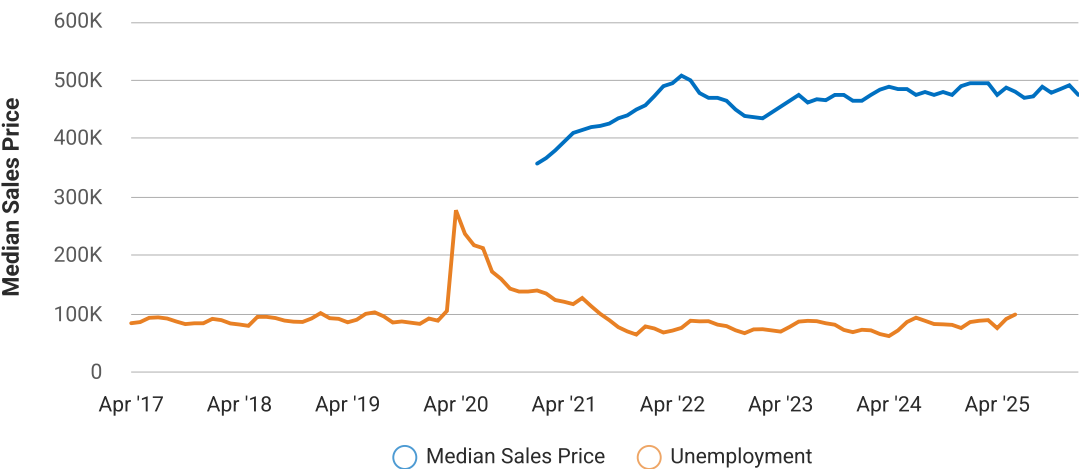

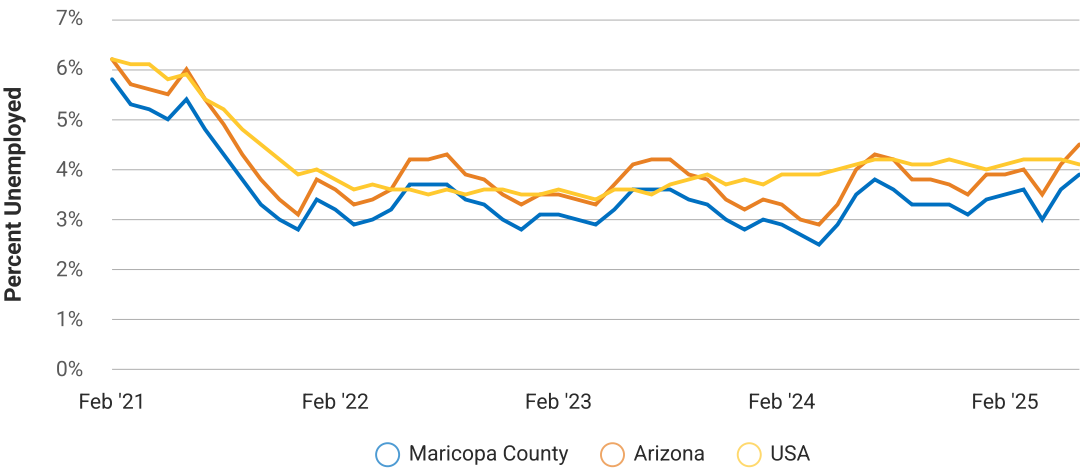


Unemployment Rate

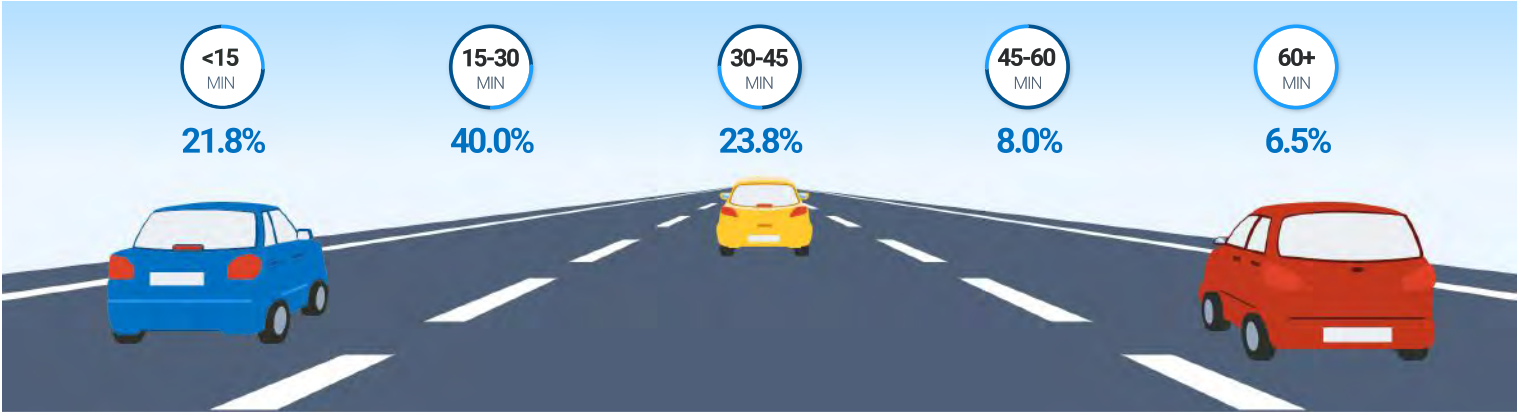


Average Commute Time

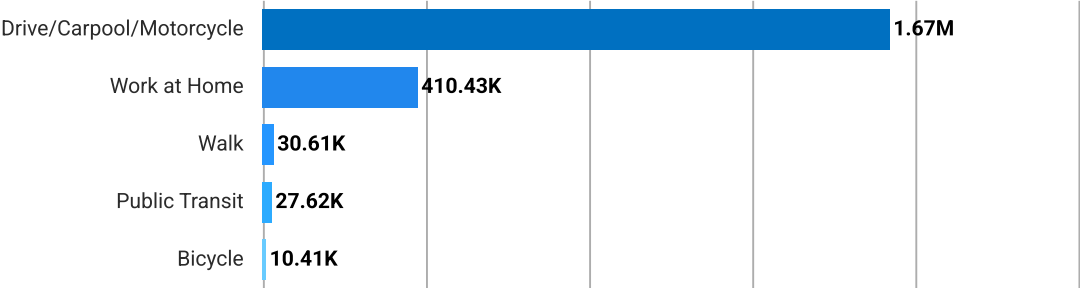


How People Get to Work

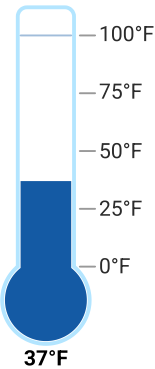
Average Monthly Temperature

This chart shows average temperatures in the area you searched.

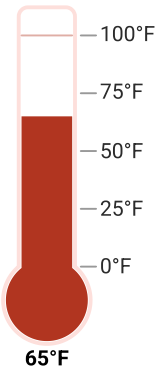

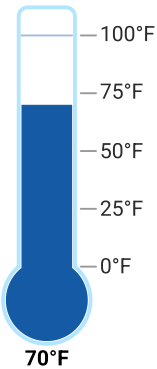

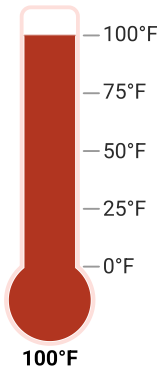
Avg. January Max. Temp
