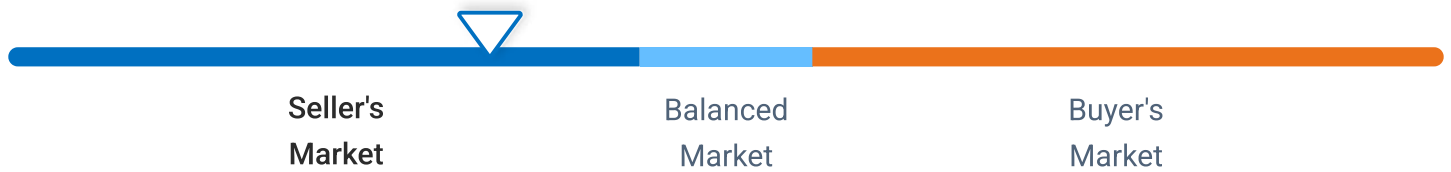

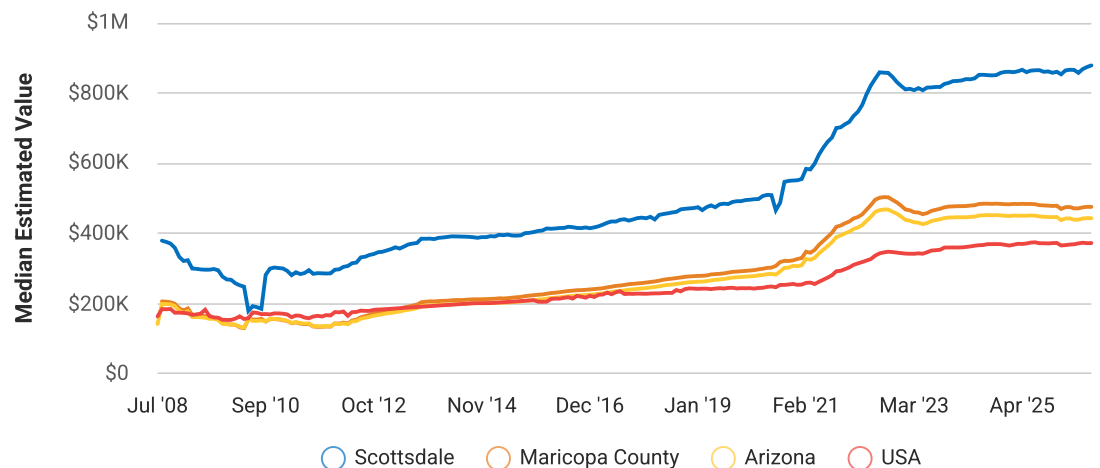

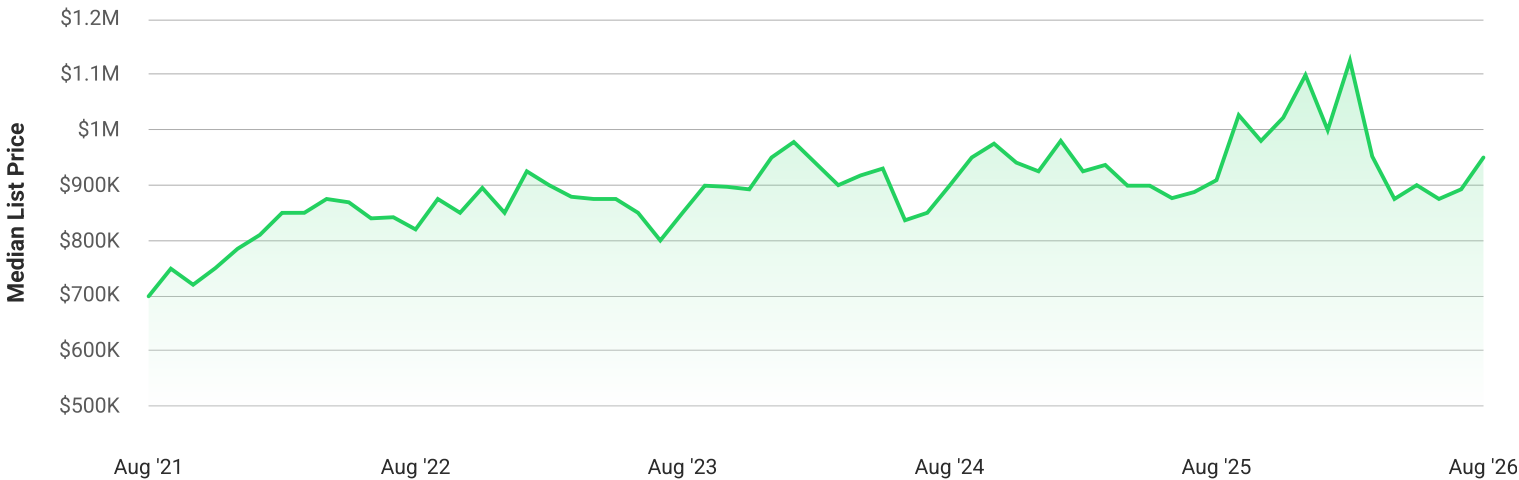

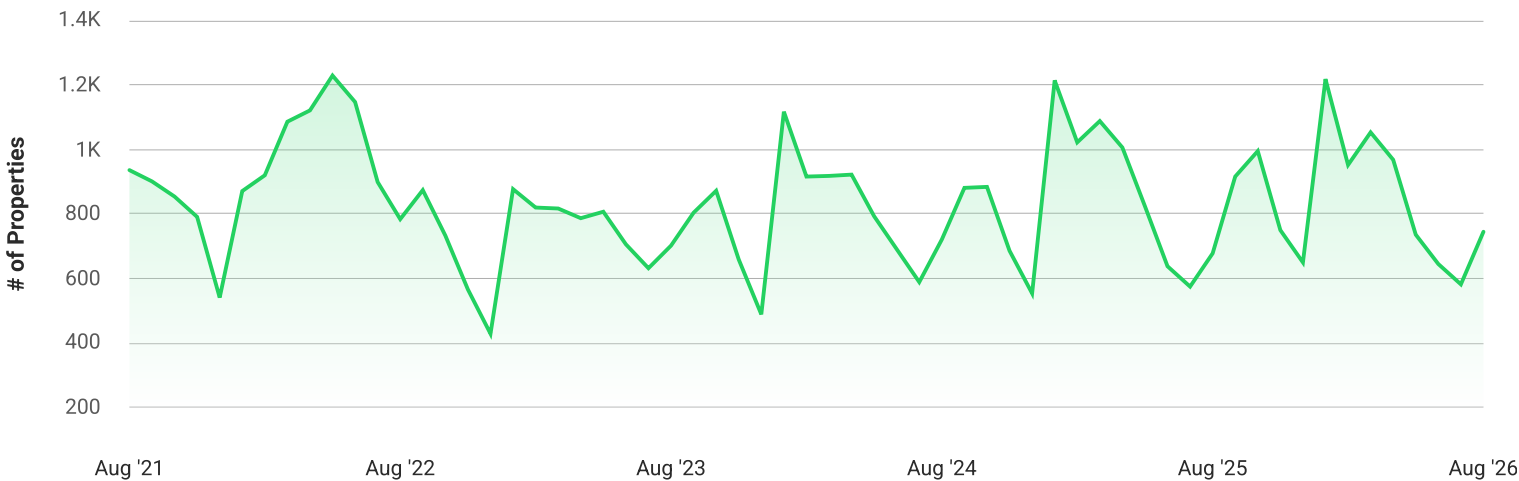

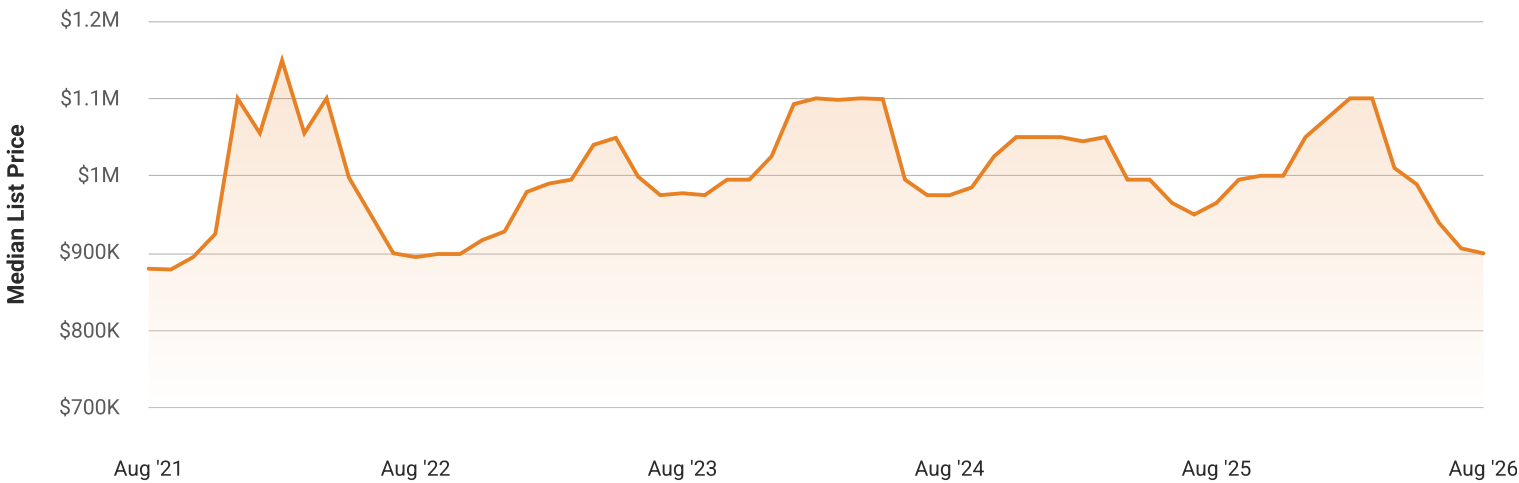

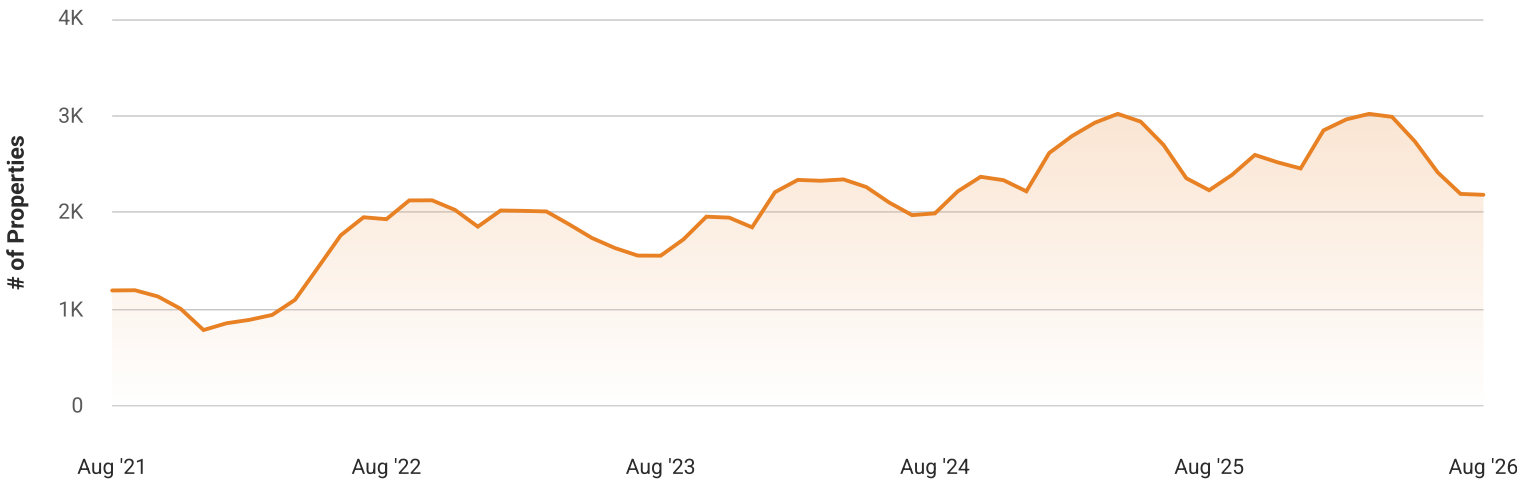

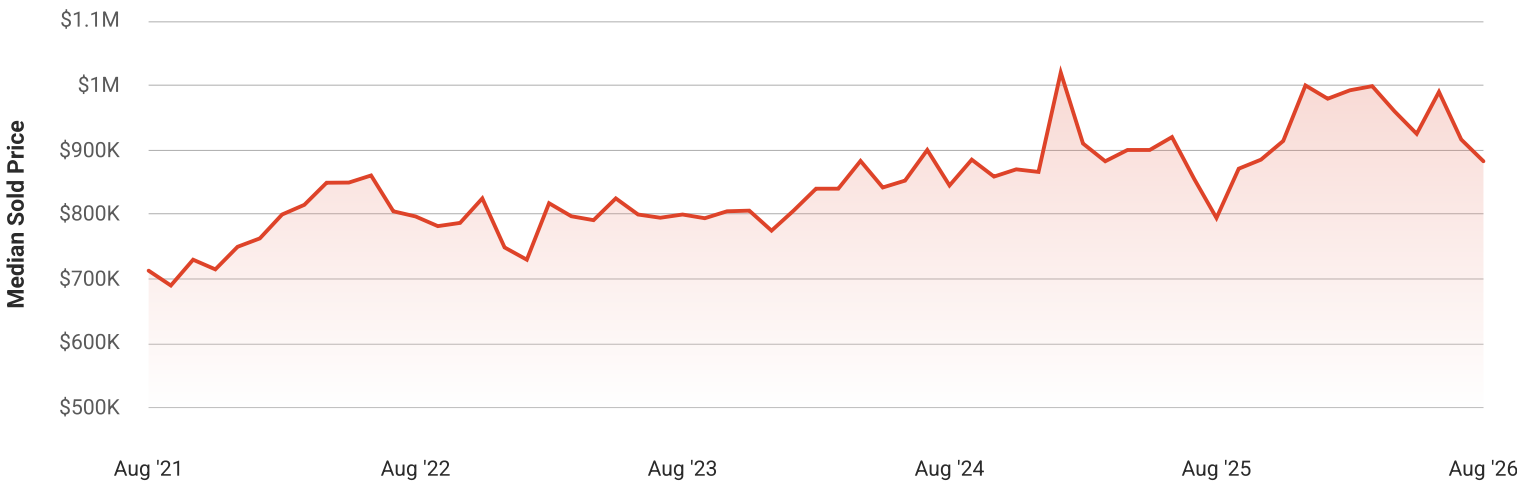

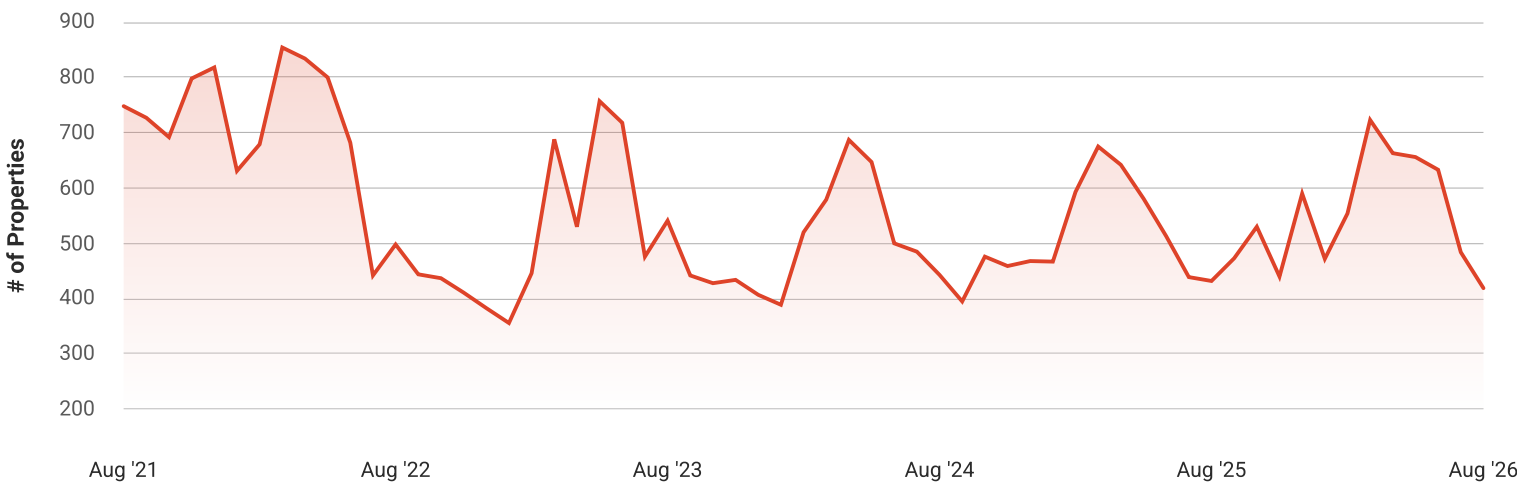

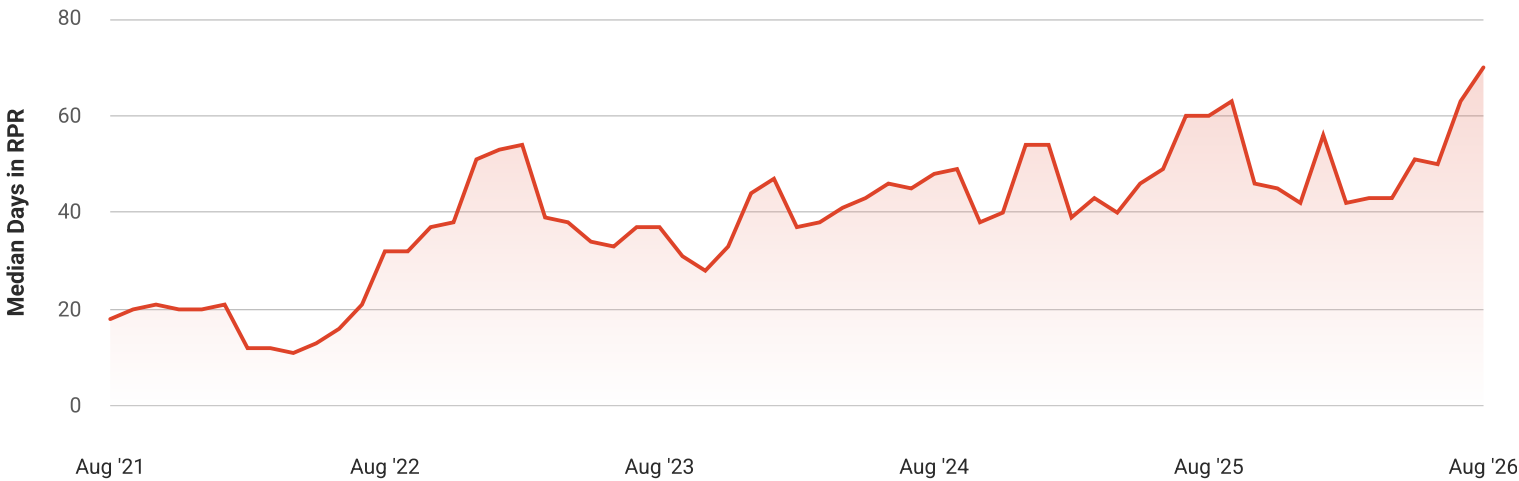

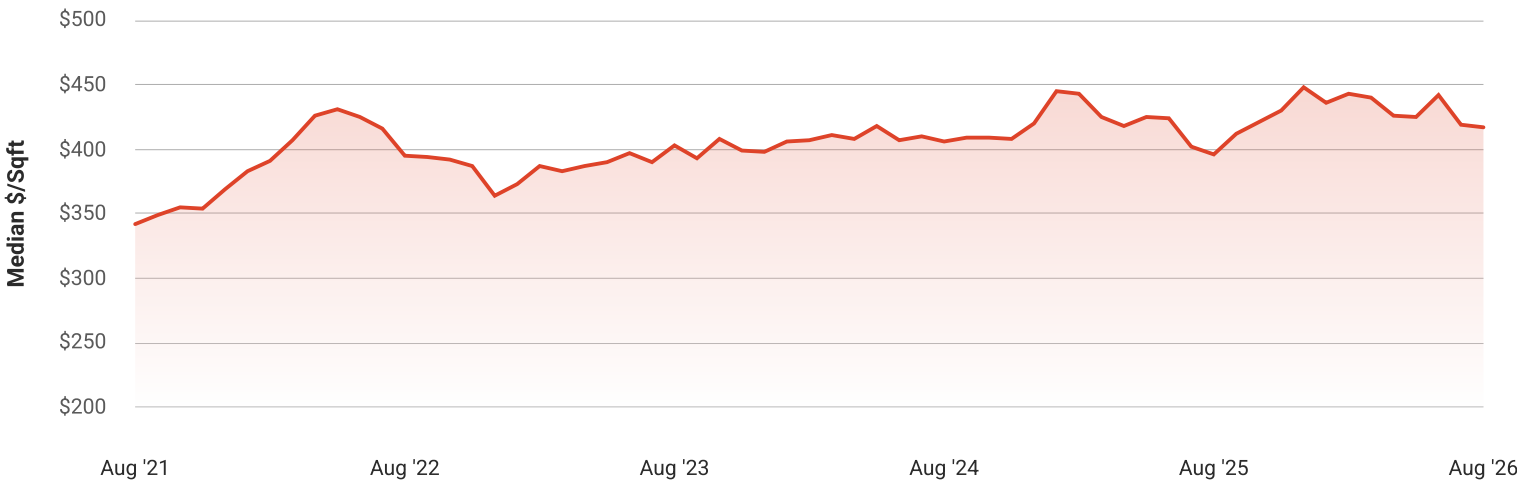

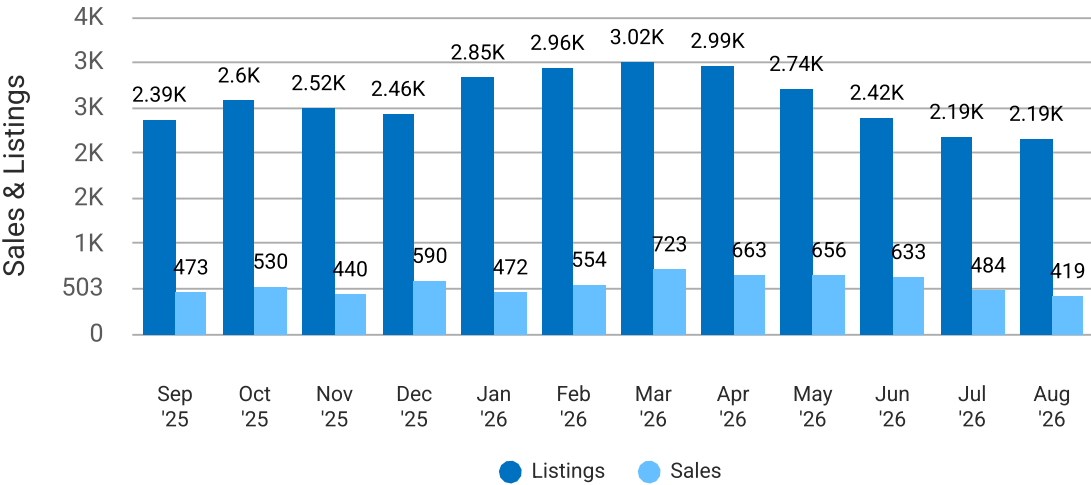
## Total Sales and Active Listings in Scottsdale, Arizona

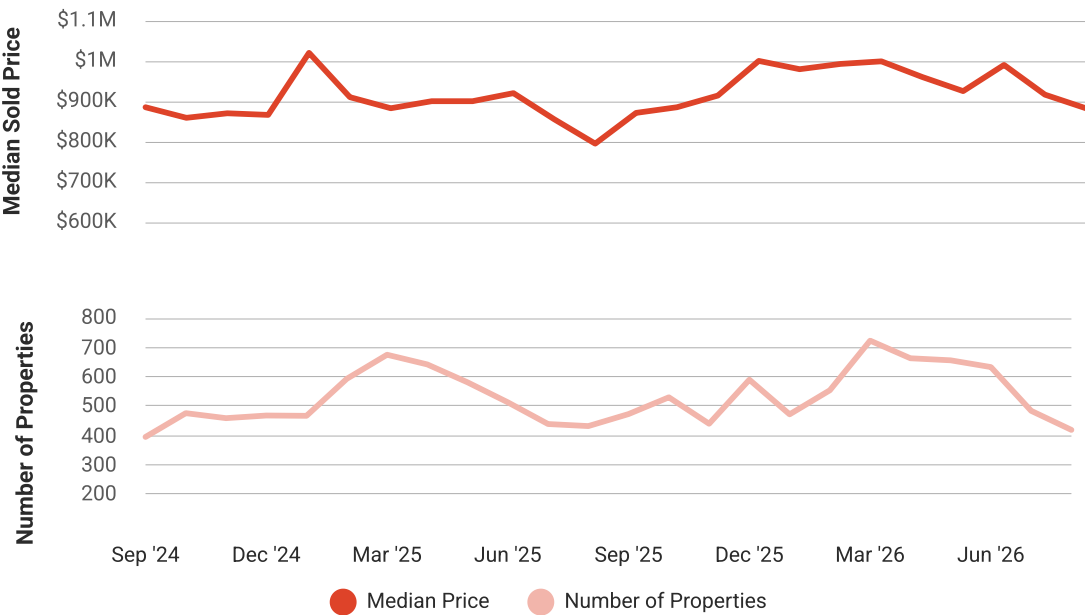
## Median Sold Price vs Sold Listings in Scottsdale, Arizona

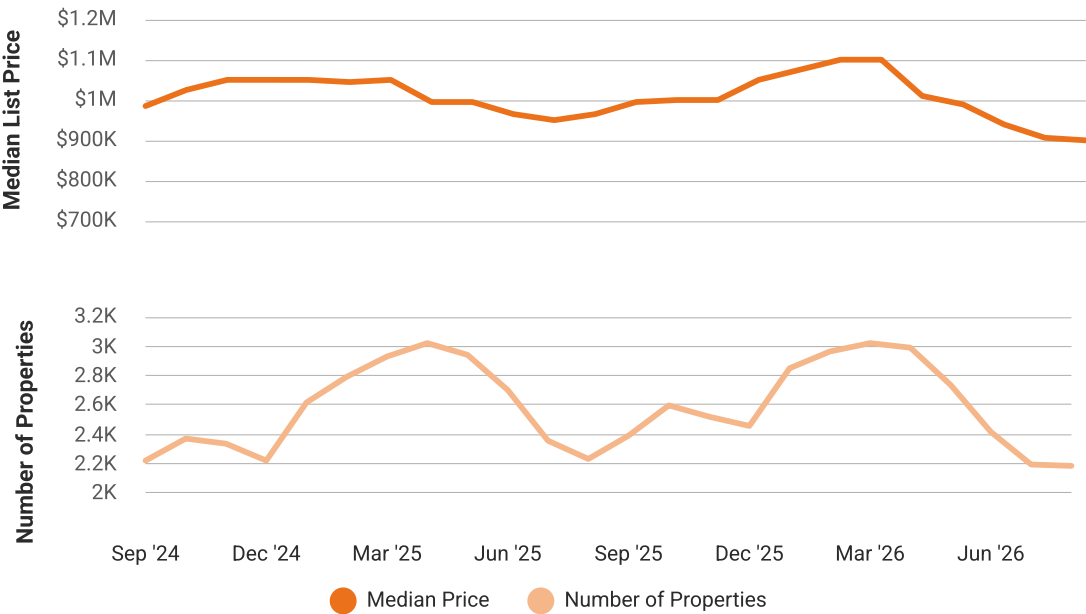
Median List Price vs Active Listings in Scottsdale, Arizona

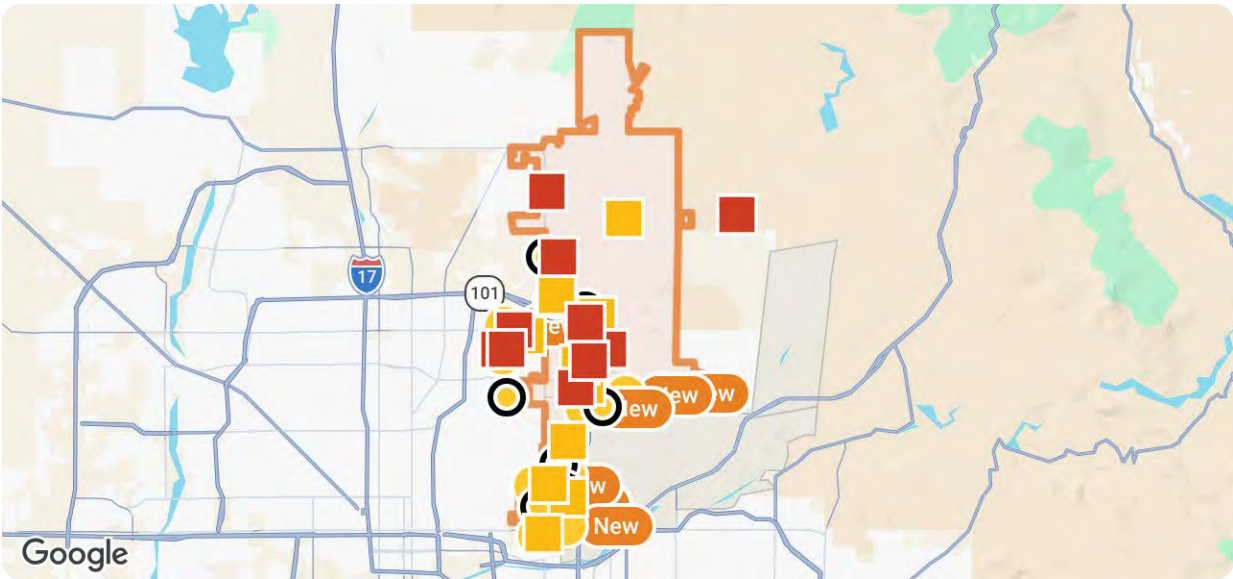

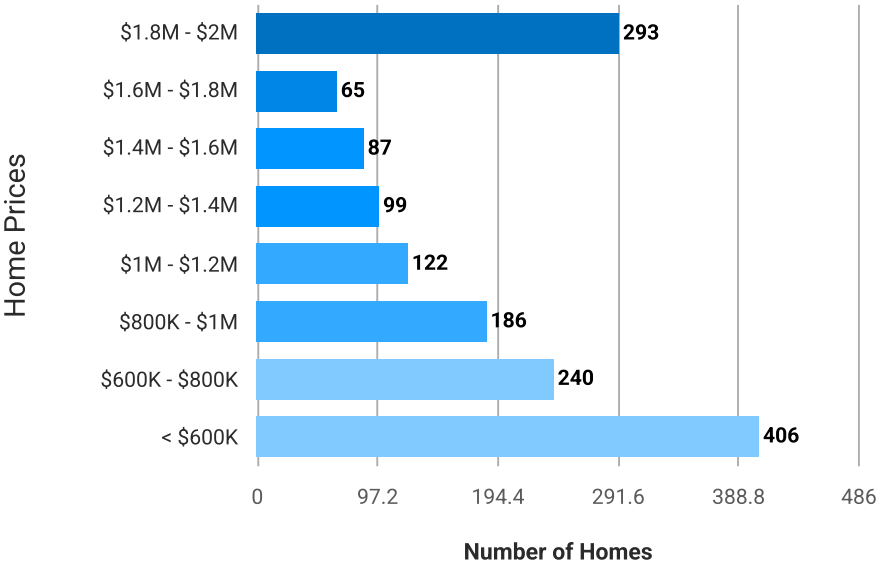

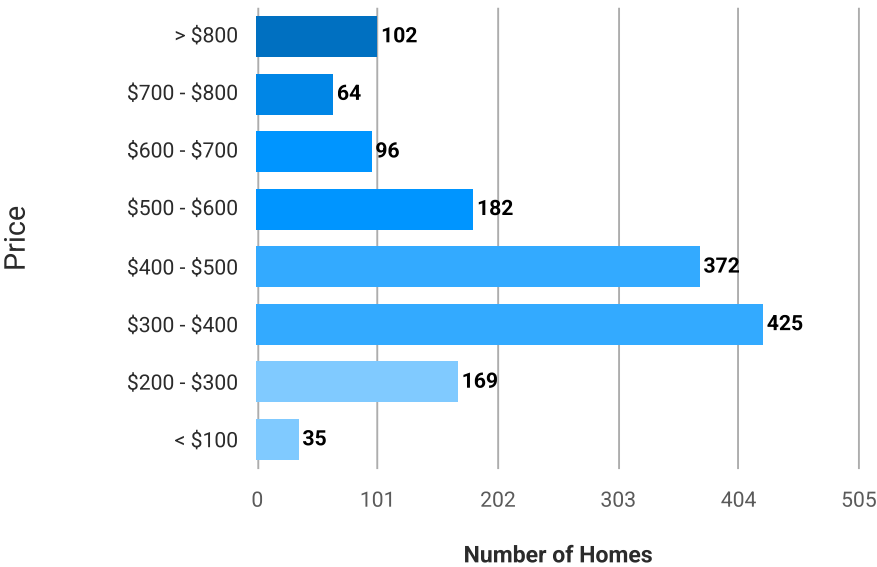


### Price per Square Foot of Comps Sold

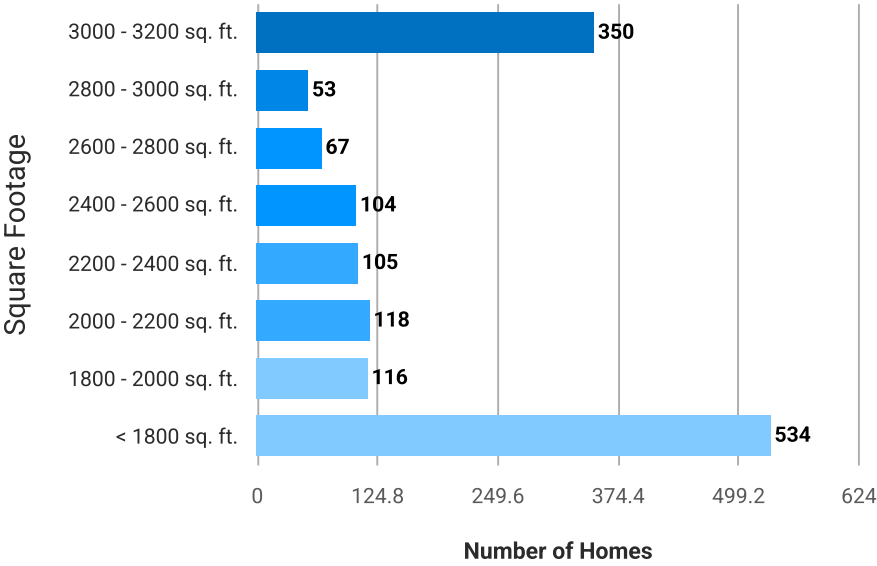


## Size of Homes Sold

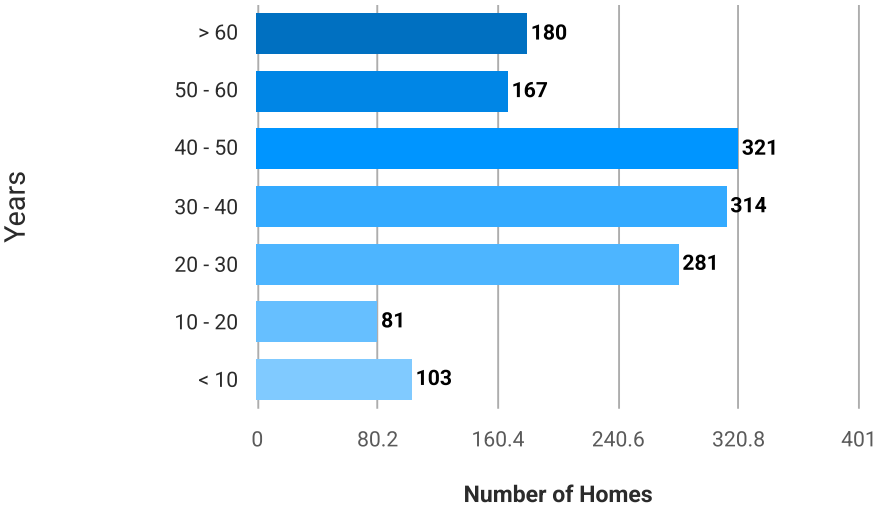


## Age Range of Comps Sold

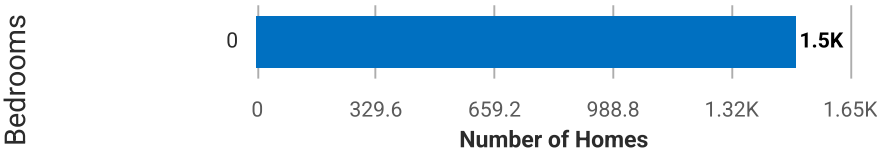


## Number of Bedrooms in Homes Sold

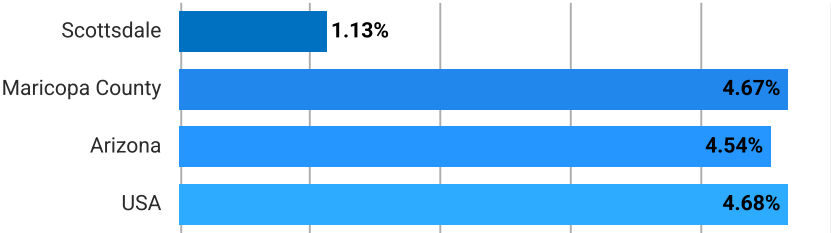

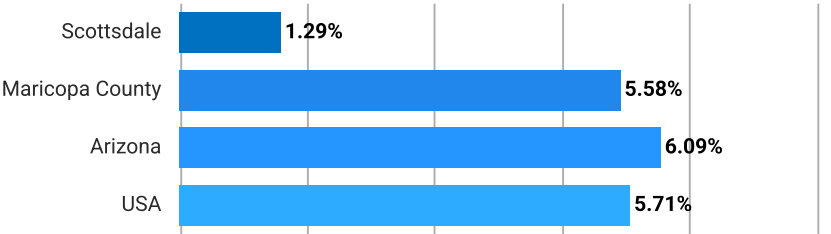

This chart shows the percentage of people in an area who have less than a ninth grade education, compared with other geographies.



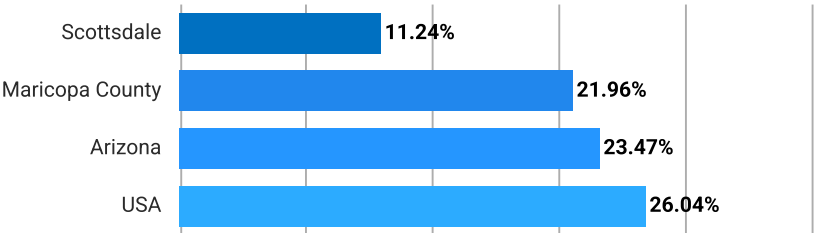
### Some High School

### High School Graduate

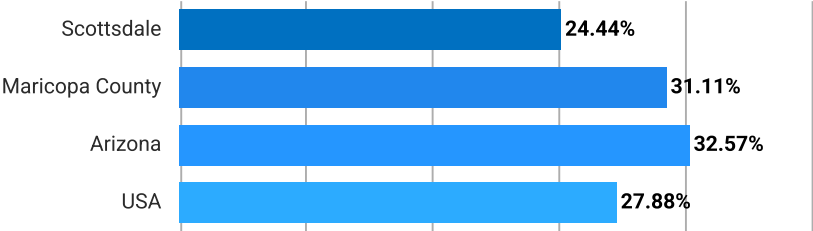
This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is high school, compared with other geographies.





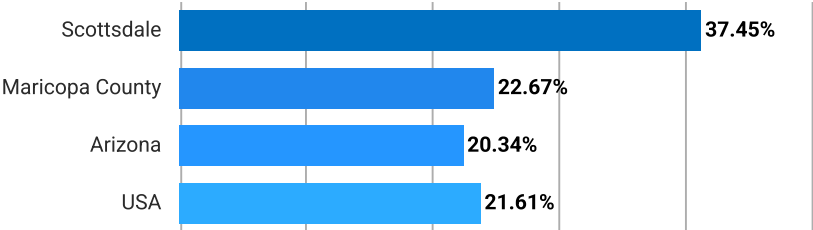
## Associate Degree

This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is an associate degree, compared with other geographies.



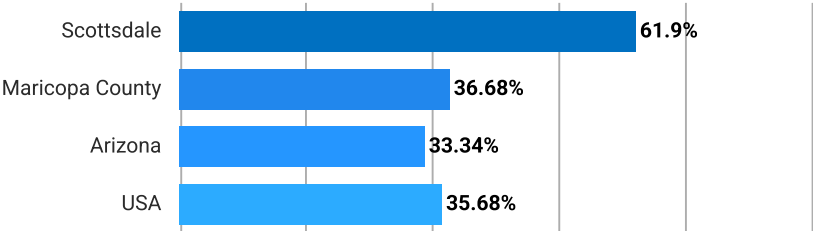
## Bachelor's Degree

This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is a bachelor's degree, compared with other geographies.



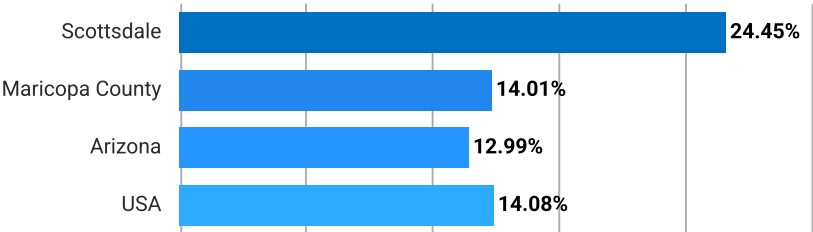
## Some College

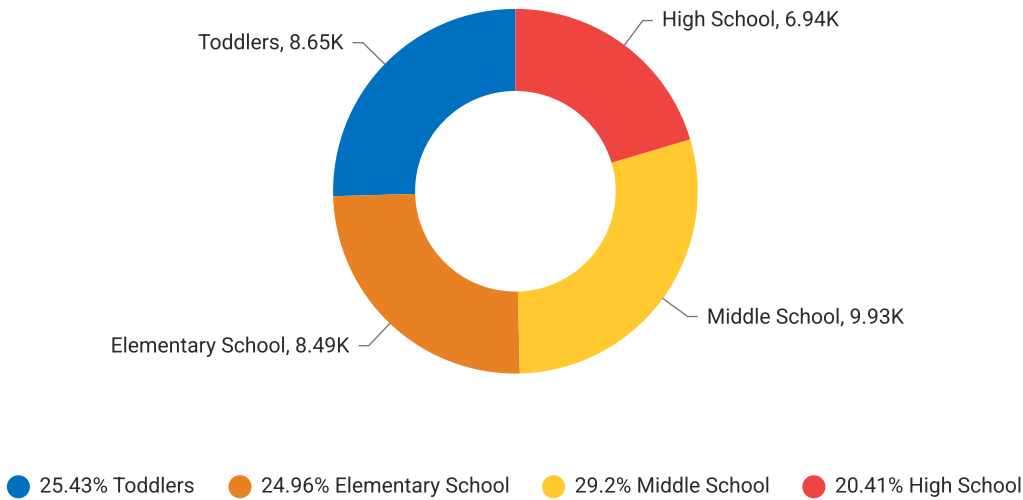


## Population of Children by Age Group in Scottsdale

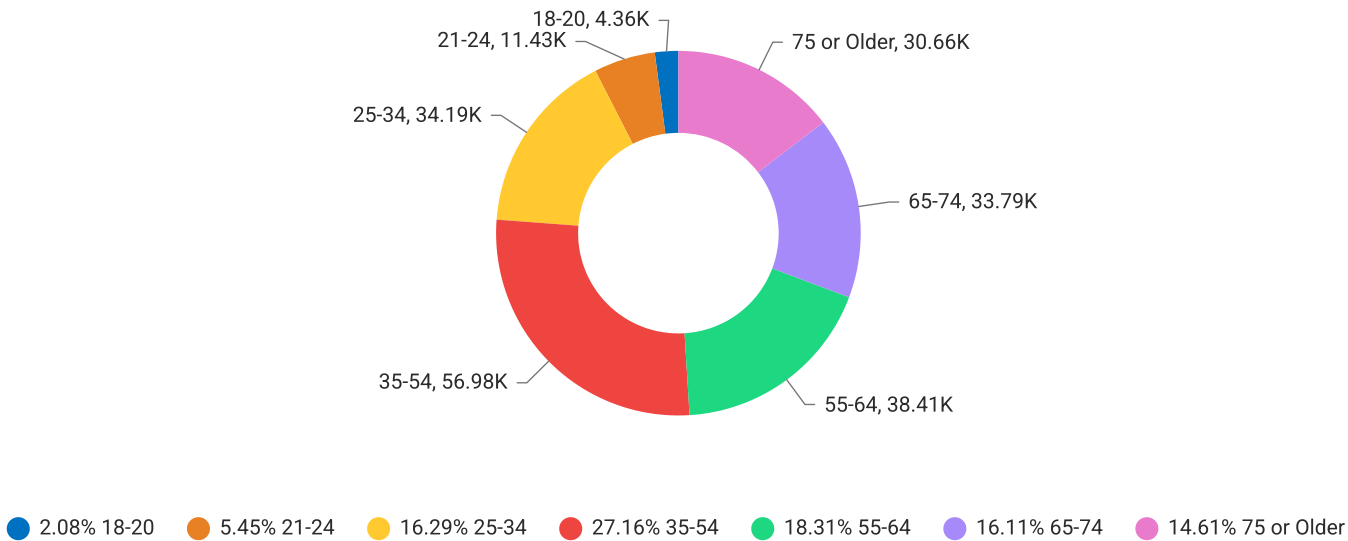


## Population of Adults by Age Group in Scottsdale

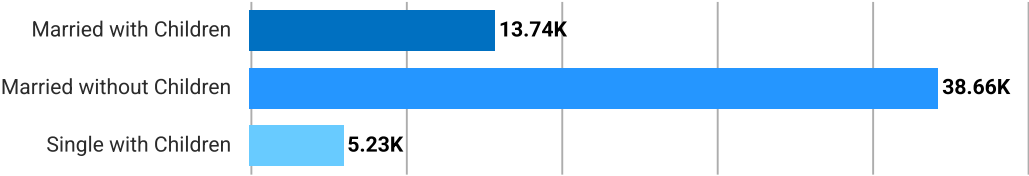


## Households With Children in Scottsdale

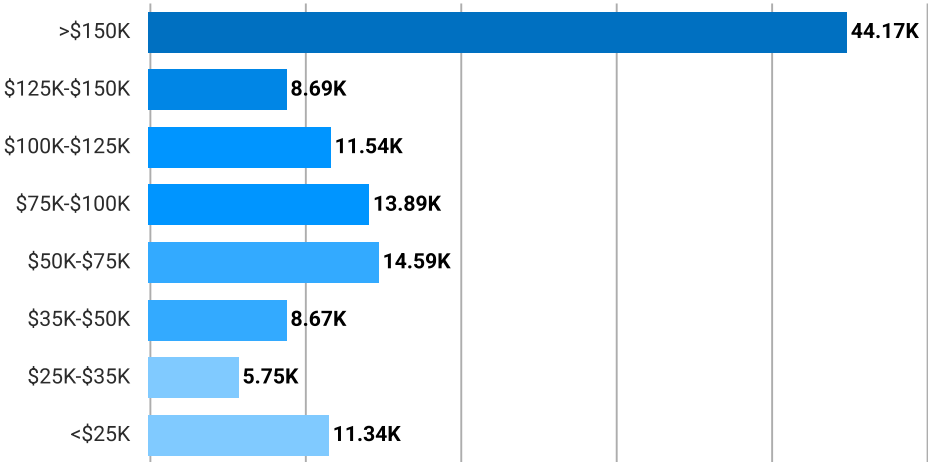


## Household Income Brackets in Scottsdale

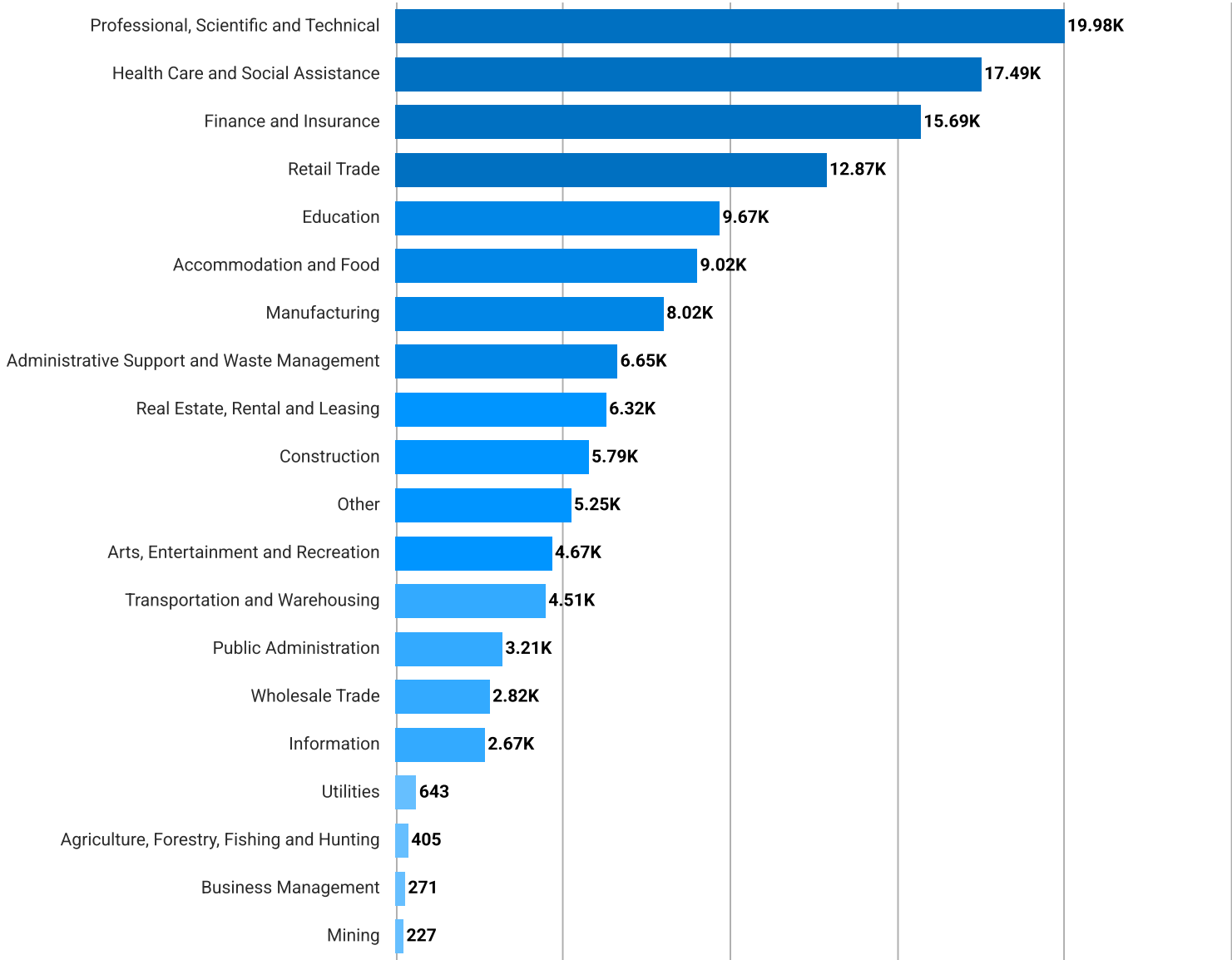


## Occupational Categories in Scottsdale

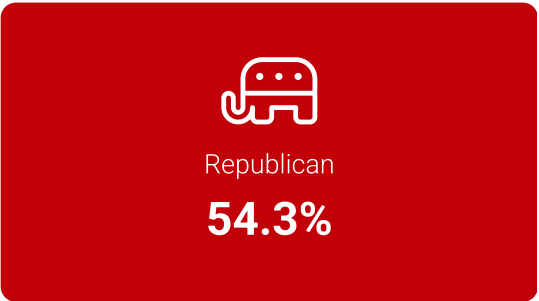
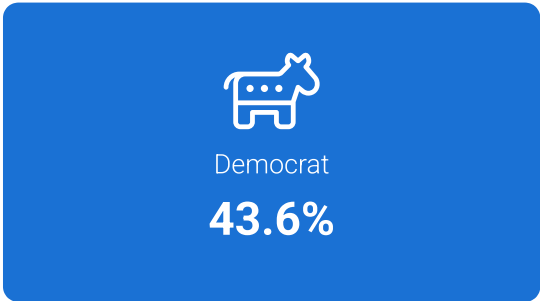


## Presidential Voting Pattern in Scottsdale

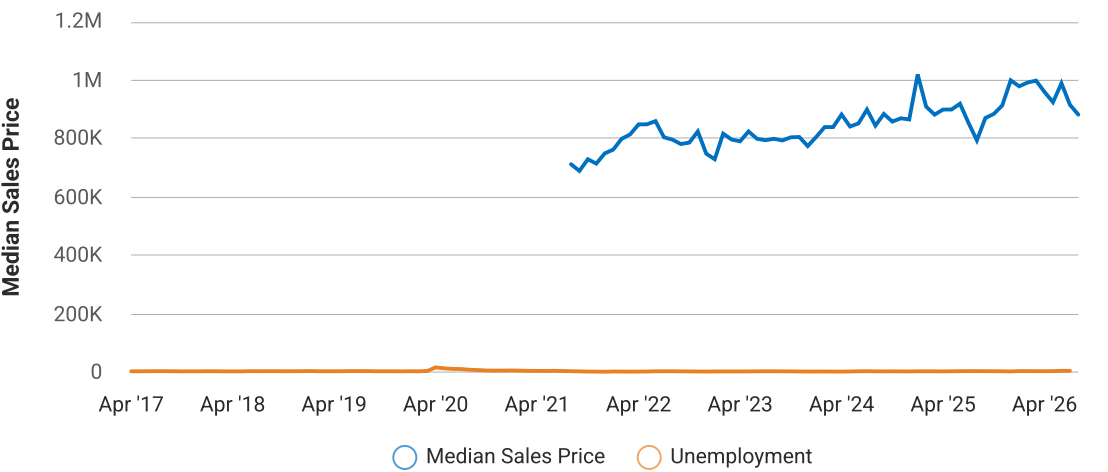

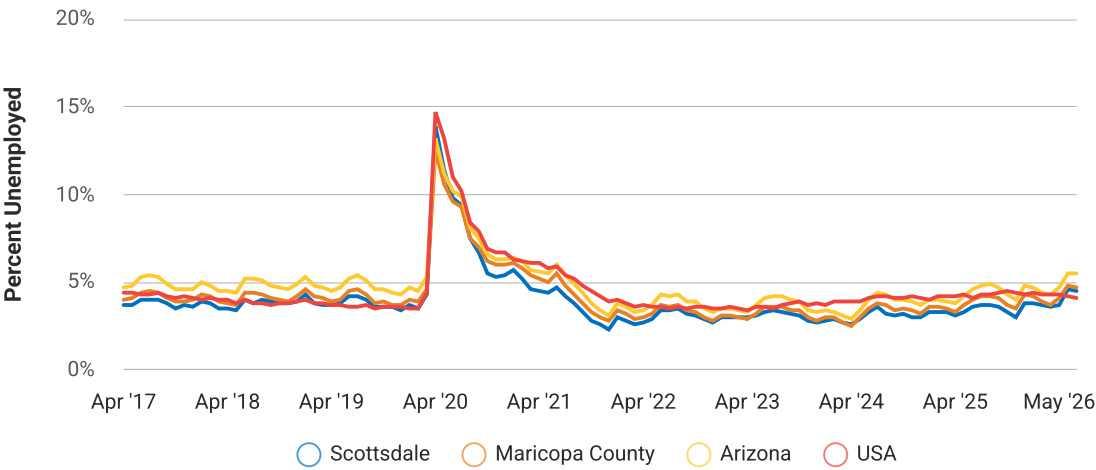


Unemployment Rate

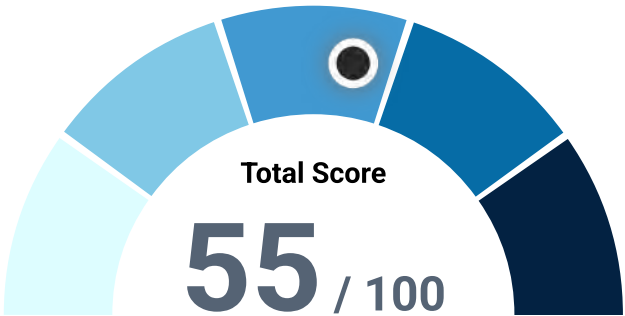

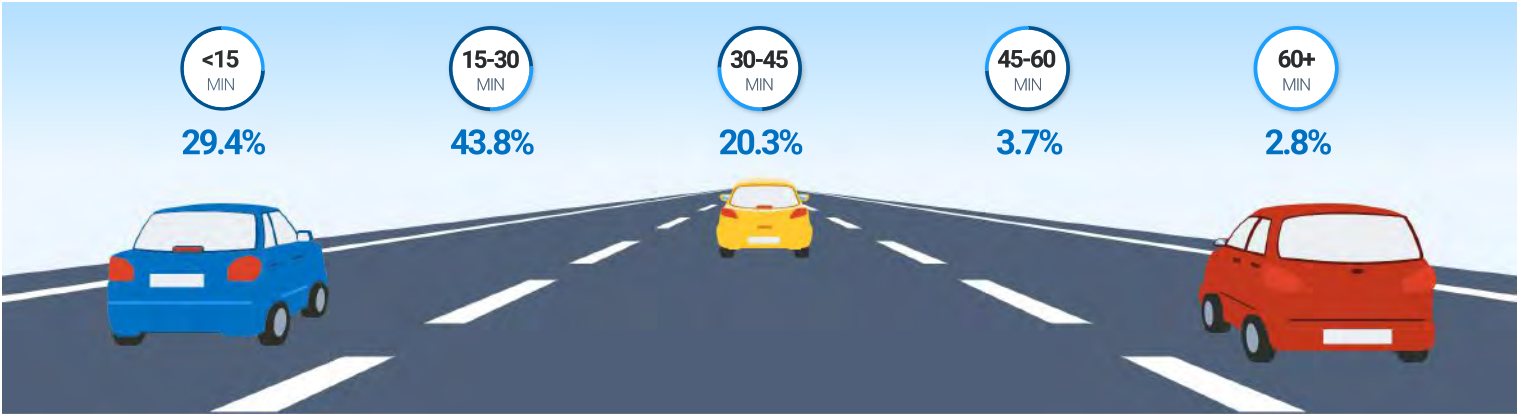

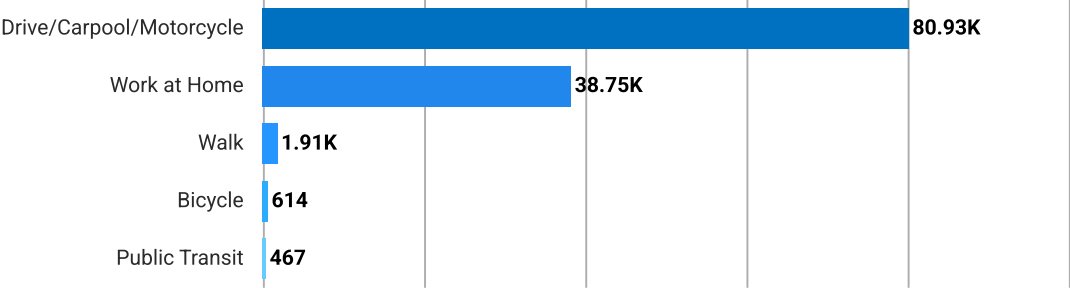


### How People Get to Work

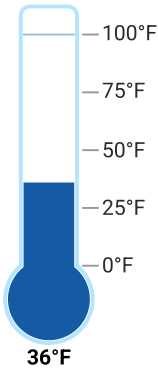
### Average Monthly Temperature

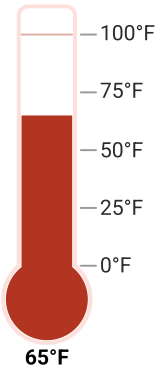

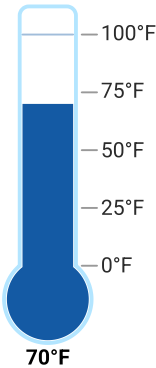

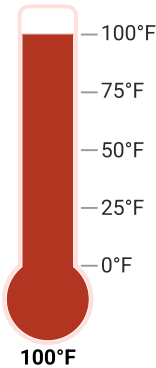
